### **Public Meeting to Discuss Brownfields Cleanup Program**

The US EPA recently awarded Peabody and Salem a \$950,000 grant to establish a revolving loan fund to support environmental remediation of brownfields and facilitate their successful redevelopment. The two cities will host an information session on Tuesday, June 30th at 6:00 p.m. at Peabody Institute Library located at 82 Main Street in downtown Peabody.

The program will provide loans with favorable terms to property owners who meet EPA eligibility requirements, show ability to repay the loan, and demonstrate that the cleanup is tied to a redevelopment plan that will benefit the community. In addition, limited subgrants that do not have to be repaid are available to eligible nonprofit organizations.
