Under the supervision of the Building Commissioner, the Wire Inspector will perform inspections (rough, partial and final) on existing and newly installed wiring systems of buildings and street wiring for conformity with legal requirements, national, state and municipal electric codes and safe practices; inspect and investigate violations of law and ordinance; inspect systems in process of construction, alteration, replacement and repair for adherence to law, regulations and codes; advise as to code requirements, issue permits and keep records of inspections; support all enforcement obligations of law and ordinance that are within duties assigned to the department.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Current Massachusetts Journeyman's License as an electrician; Master Lic. preferred.
- Have been employed as a licensed journeyman for five (5) years.
- At least two (2) years of responsibility for direct administrative duties and functions in trade practices, completing application processes and preparing/reviewing plans.
- Ability to read plans and provide written plan review reports.
- Valid Massachusetts Driver's License and own vehicle.
- Ability to lift 25 pounds; ability to climb stairs without impediment; ability to enter to inspect properly a variety of spaces, large and small without impediment.
- Be conversant in English and be clear and complete in written and verbal communication.
- Ability to fully utilize modern computer technology in every facet of the functions of inspection, all actions subject to record keeping.

**Physical Demands: (refer to full description)**

Moderate to strenuous effort required periodically in the field. Frequently required to stoop, bend and reach. Must be able to access all areas of a construction site. May occasionally lift and/or move heavy objects Vision and hearing at or correctable to normal ranges; ability to distinguish colors.
