LICENSING BOARD

July 1, 2014

TO THE HOLDERS OF SECTION 12 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POURING LICENSES:

THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERN THE CLOSING HOURS THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF PEABODY.

HOURS: Monday – Saturday 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m. the following day
Sunday 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m. the following day

CONDITIONS: The Consumption of alcoholic beverages shall cease at 1:00 a.m.
All glasses bottles and other receptacles used for dispensing of alcoholic beverages shall be removed from the bars and tables not later than 1:15 a.m., patrons off the premises by 1:30 a.m., all employees off the premises (unless involved in cleaning or food preparation) and premises secured by 2:00 a.m.

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138, no alterations shall be made without approval of the Licensing Authorities.

TO THE HOLDERS OF ALL ALCOHOLIC AND WINE AND MALT PACKAGE STORE LICENSES:

HOURS: Monday – Saturday 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.
Sunday – 12 noon until 11:00 p.m.


PREMISES LICENSED HEREUNDER SHALL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY THE LICENSING BOARD MEMBERS, THEIR AGENTS, AND THE CITY OF PEABODY POLICE.

The licensee is subject to suspension, revocation, or forfeiture for breach of any of its conditions, regulations or any law of the Commonwealth.

LICENSING BOARD REGULATIONS

1. Any Licensee intending to close his place of business must notify the Board in writing before such closing, and the Licensee shall state in such notice the reason and length of such closing.
2. (a) No Licensee shall contract bills for his licensed place under any corporate or trade name other than that under which it is licensed.

(b) Corporation managers in licensed places must not be changed until the Licensing Board has approved such change.
3. Assignment of stock in corporation licensed places for the purpose of safeguarding the assignee on loans, etc., gives no right to such assignee to conduct the business of the Licensee; therefore, Licensees must notify the Board immediately when the Assignee forecloses under such assignment of stock.
4. (a) Licensee shall immediately notify the Board of any proceeding brought against them or any proceedings brought by themselves under the Bankruptcy laws.

(b) Licensee shall immediately notify the Board of any court proceedings which may affect the status of the license.
5. There shall be no disturbance, disorder, indecency, prostitution, lewdness or illegality of any kind to take place in or on the licensed premises. The Licensee shall be responsible therefor, whether present or not.
6. All alcoholic beverages sold must be opened and consumed on the premises.
7. No Licensee shall keep for sale, store, or sell alcoholic beverages in any part of the premises not specified on this license.

8. The licensed premises shall be subject to inspection by the police of the City of Peabody, the State Police, and any duly authorized agents of the Licensing Board.
9. No physical renovations shall be made unless a plan is submitted and approved by the Board.
10. No employee and/or entertainer shall solicit, induce or request a patron to purchase any alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverage for them or any other person. Nothing shall prohibit the above activity in connection with any contact which such person may have with a patron to whom they are related by blood or marriage.
11. (a) A current list of employees shall be available upon request of authorized agents of the Board.

(b) Licensed managers are required to take an alcohol intervention course.
12. No alcoholic beverages shall be sold for a fee less than the actual cost of the beverage to the Licensee. An admission charge shall not be credited towards the purchase price of any alcoholic beverage.
13. No Licensee shall make any distinction, discrimination, or restriction on account of race, color, religious creed, national origin, sex or ancestry relative to the admission or treatment of any person.
14. This license is subject to suspension, revocation, or forfeiture for breach of any of its conditions or regulations of which the Licensee has notice, or any law of the Commonwealth.
15. All licenses and building certificates shall be displayed on the premises in a conspicuous position where they may easily be seen and read.

16. Any police complaints and/or reports presently on file shall continue in force until disposed of by the Board.
17. No device or electronic equipment shall be utilized by any licensed premises for purposes of signaling employees that agents or licensing authorities are present.
18. The Licensing Board reserves the right to charge or add to the foregoing terms and conditions after notice to the Licensee.
