Information for spectators:

The show will feature over 100 antique cars from collectors all over the New England region. you'll be able to shop and explore the work of nearly 50 local crafters. Parking for spectators:

- There is no designated parking area for spectators attending the event. However, there are two municipal lots in the area that will have parking available and free of charge. One is located on Foster Street across from Petrillo's Restaurant and the other is located on Central Street next to the Dunkin Donuts.
- If you park on a side street please be mindful of driveways and fire hydrants.

Information for Car Show participants:

- Participants of the Car Show will meet in the parking lot of the Peabody Elks at 40 Oak Street.
- They will then be directed to Main Street by volunteers. Participants are not allowed to set their cars up on Main Street until 9:00 a.m. per order of the Peabody Police Department.
