Free Shuttle Service for Concert / Fireworks Goers *Satellite Parking Locations Announced*

Those planning to attend the ‘City of Peabody Centennial Concert and Fireworks Spectacular’ on July 23rd at Peabody Veterans Memorial High School can take advantage of free shuttle service to and from the event at four satellite parking locations. The event kicks off at 6pm with live music and culminates with a concert by the US Navy Band and the first city-sponsored fireworks display in nearly 20 years.

Parking at Peabody High School and the McVann O’Keefe Skate Rink is reserved only for people with disabilities, military veterans, public safety personnel and event staff and volunteers.

All other attendees may park at one of the following satellite parking locations in Peabody to access round trip shuttle transportation:

- The North Shore Shopping Center parking lot next to East Boston Savings Bank
- Bonker’s Plaza at 535 Lowell Street
- West Peabody Business Park at 83 Pine Street (formerly the Kennedy Junior High School)
- The Peter A. Torigian Senior Center at 75R Central Street

Continuous shuttle service from all four satellite parking locations will begin at 5pm and continue until one hour following the event.

In addition to bleacher seating at Peabody High School, family picnic areas have been designated for concert and fireworks viewing. Backpacks, bags and coolers are subject to random search by Peabody police and event staff. Food is prohibited on the athletic field and there will be no food vendors on site.
