Peabody's International Festival is famous for its variety of food from different regions all over the globe. Though what really sets the atmosphere of the festival is the entertainment that takes place at two different stages throughout the day. No two musical or dance groups are the same, as each represents a distinct cultural and ethnic performance. Many festival favorites are set to return to the stage this year along with some new additions.

The Kubota Power Jazz Unit with Samurai Taiko also returns to rock the stage with a mix of Japanese Taiko drumming. Each musical group will be assigned to one of two stages at either end of the event. There will be a stage located at Peabody Square and another at the top of Main Street at the corner of Washington Street.
