The cities of Salem and Peabody have jointly received a grant from the Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC) to develop a Concept Action Plan for the Boston/Main Street corridor from the intersection of Boston and Essex Street in Salem to Main and Central Street in Peabody. This collaborative project will include:

- Analysis of current land use, zoning, economic development opportunities, and pedestrian access;
- Identifying opportunities for infill development and growth in the established corridors;
- Development of a vision for the neighborhood;
- Creating a focus map and action plan for the corridor;
- Recommendations for consistency throughout the corridor, specifically in regards to zoning, signage, and bike/pedestrian/access/traffic safety;

Please join us for the first of two public meetings regarding this project. At this meeting, MAPC will give a summary of the project and present preliminary data regarding the corridor.

Members of the public are encouraged to attend and bring comments and suggestions for the development of the Boston/Main St corridor.
