COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE AUGUST 25, 2011

P603-11 COUNCILLOR MANNING-MARTIN– Reporting for the Committee of the Whole –We had a Committee of the Whole that happened this evening at 6 o'clock. In attendance were Councillors: Gravel, Bettencourt, Osborne, Liacos, Gamache, Garabedian, Mello, Sinewitz and Athas and myself. We had two items that we discussed. Mayor Michael Bonfanti joined us to give the Council an update on Massachusetts Health Reform Law and Sue Shillue from Cook & Company, a consultant, addressed the Council to familiarize us and educate us on the process of the health reform law. What we were told is that it's a very complex issue, which will evolve as the cities and towns get into it, and there's a lot of work left to be done in the planning and implementation of it. She stresses that the number one priority for the city would be to develop a strategy that is what is most important. The strategy should include what the changes are that the City would want, whether to select to enter into the GIC program if we choose to and to provide cost analysis for all of the decisions that would need to be made and come up with a projected savings. Again it was a very in-depth conversation. It was a complex issue. The mayor assured everyone that he's working to come up with the best strategy and the best plan for the city and its employees moving forward and he will update us again when he's better prepared to advise us of what that strategy is, but he does have every intention of moving forward. Another item that was discussed was the update on the design of Main Street Corridor Realignment Program. Ms. Karen Sawyer joined us to give us an update on that. The grant application, in order to move forward, is due the first week in September. That is the deadline. She came forward to us looking for approval from the Council to go forward for the grant application. There were a lot of public outreach meetings. Salem was also reached out to to see if they had any concerns with our proposal and they reported back that our proposal coordinates well with their plan for Boston Street. There were many letters of support from businesses and residents, Senator Berry, Representative Spiliotis as well. All put forward letters of approval in recommending that the City move forward with the Main Street Corridor Realignment Program. (Report received)
