The lowest observed value was 3.7 on 9/9/2020.

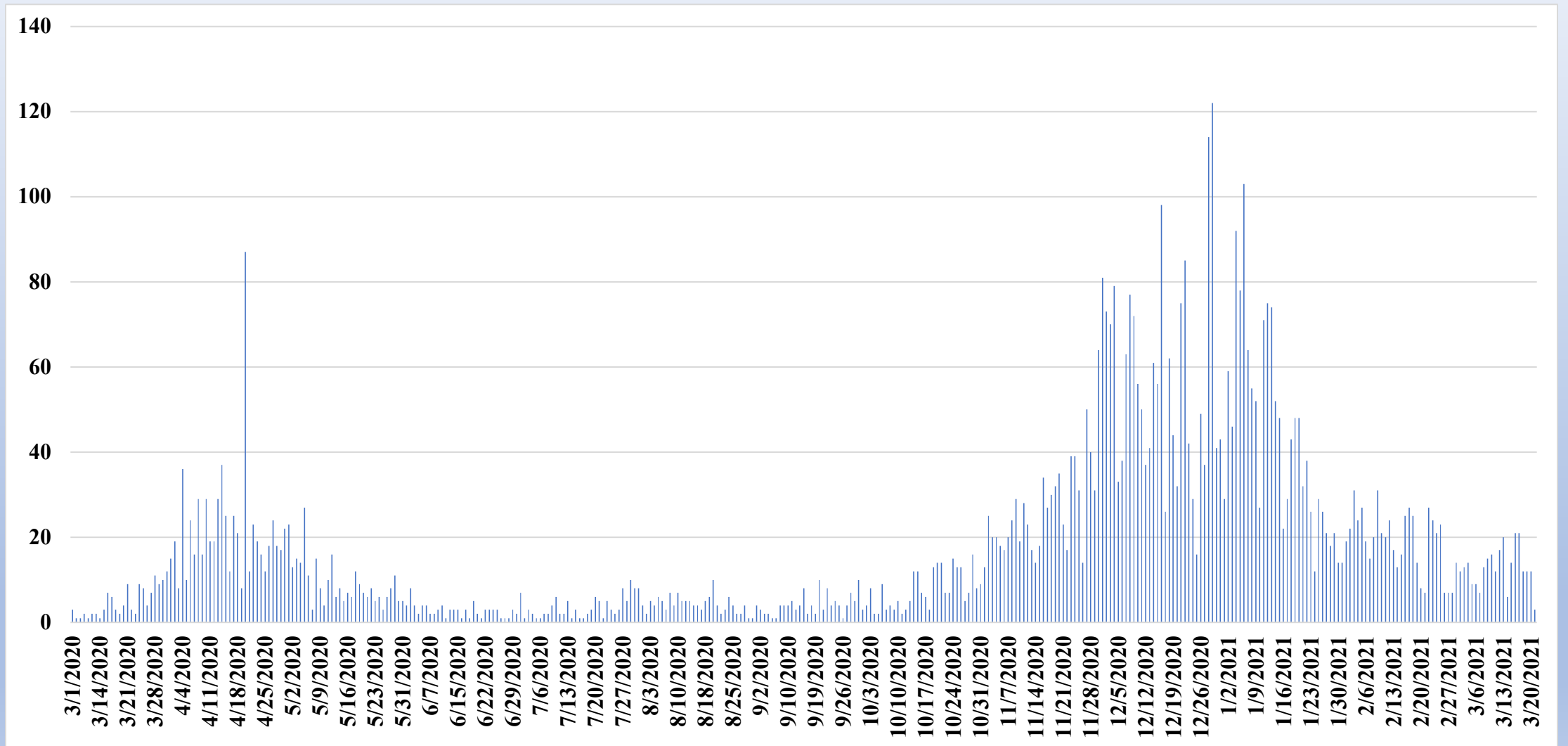

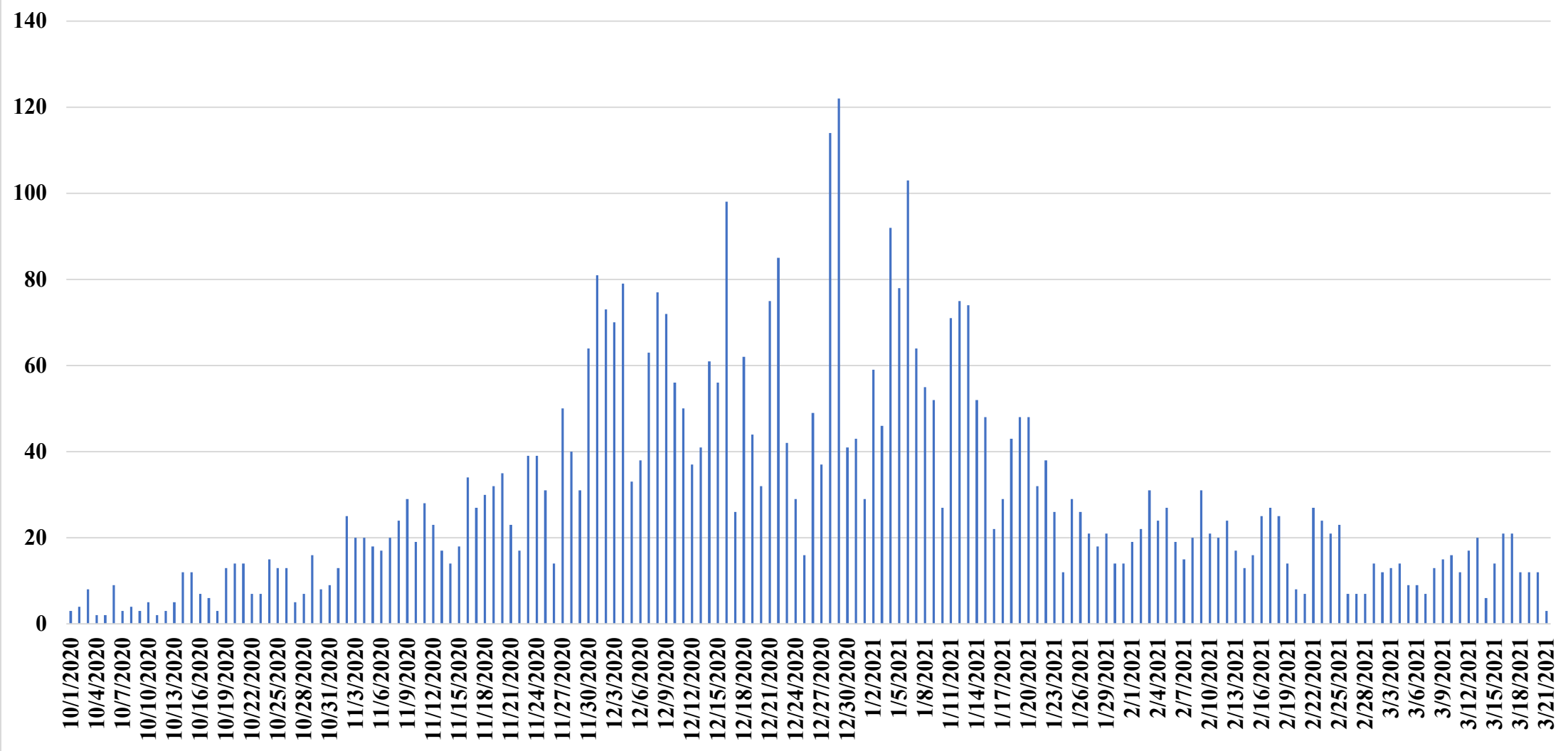

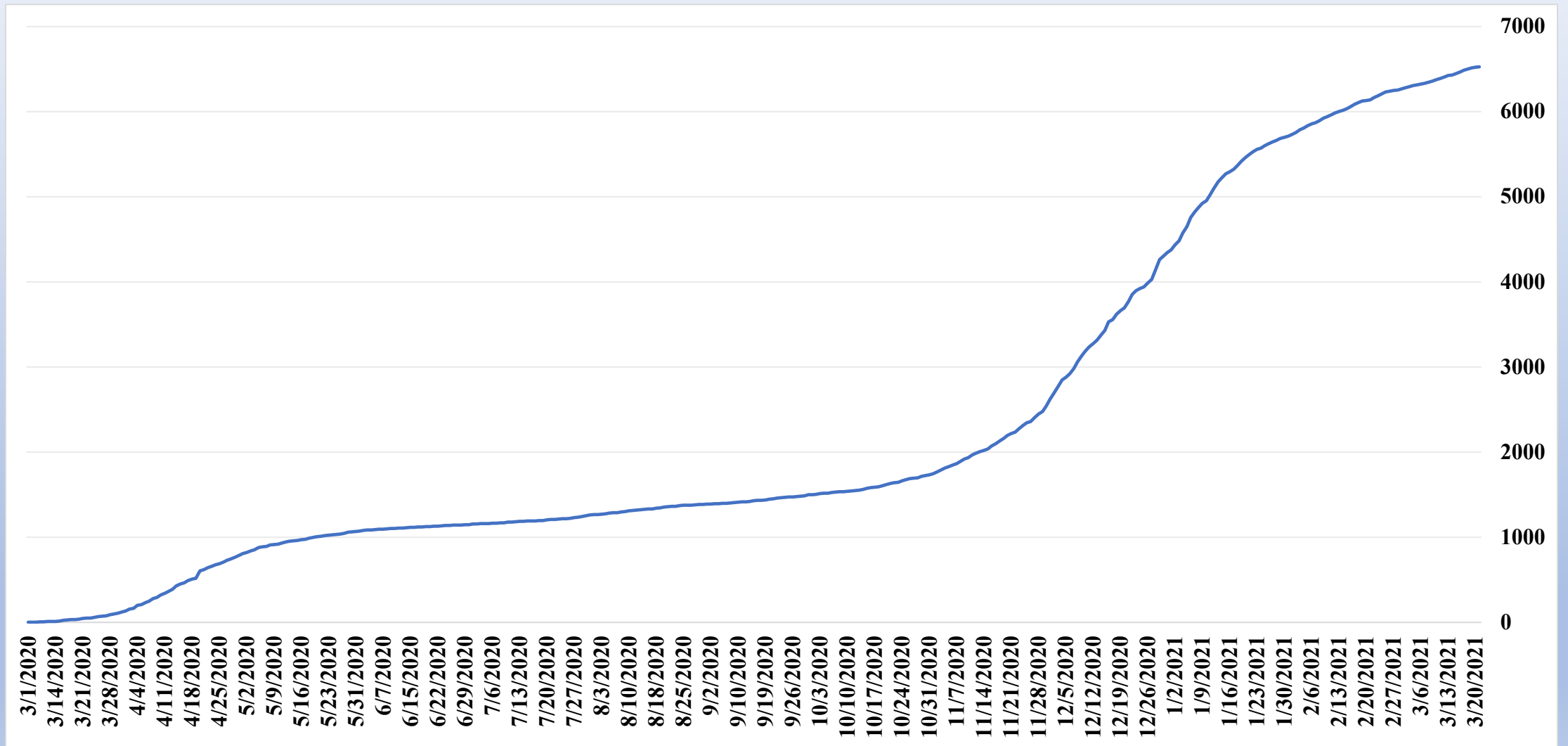
# Peabody Daily Confirmed Cases by Date– 3/22/21



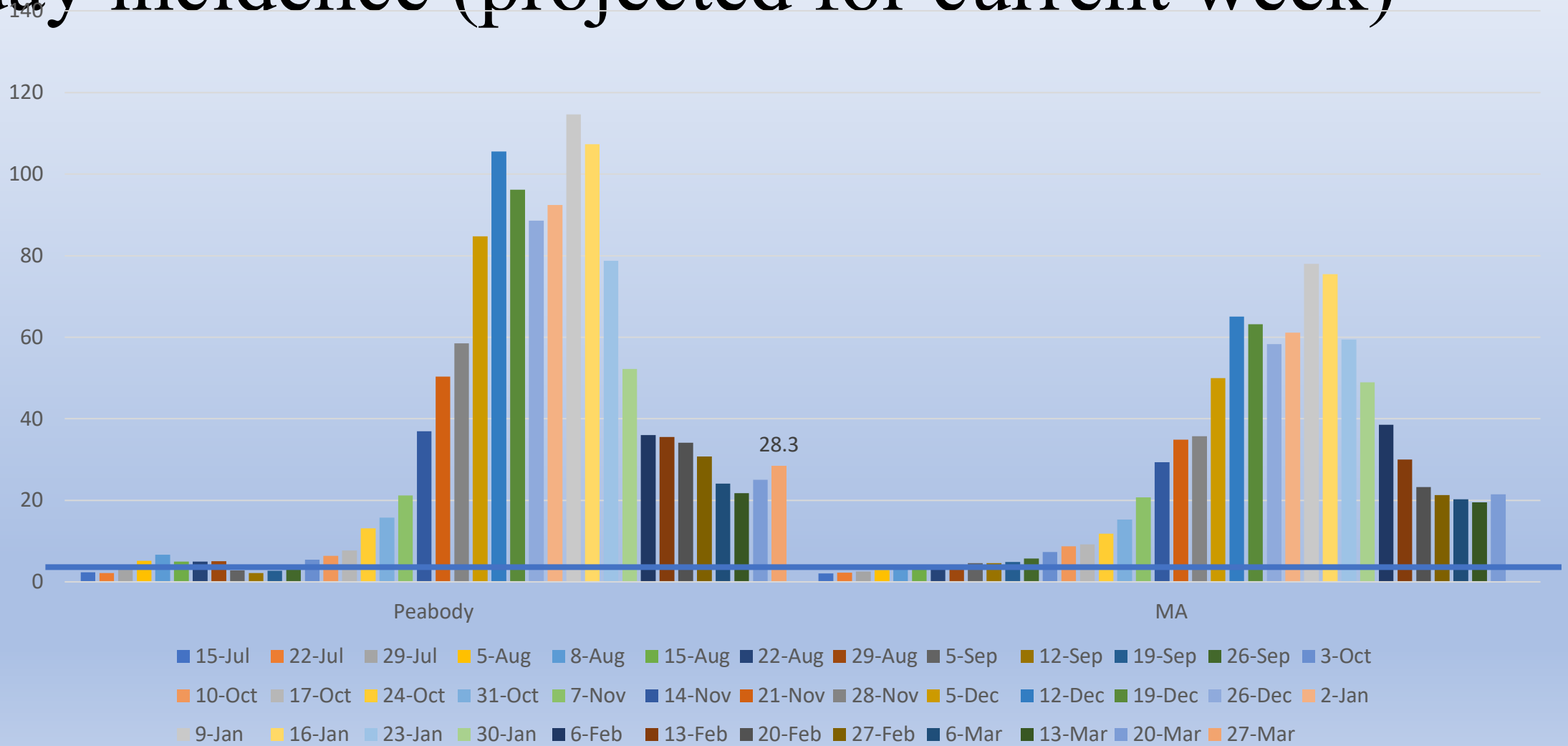
# Peabody Daily Confirmed Cases by Date– 10/1/20 to 3/22/21



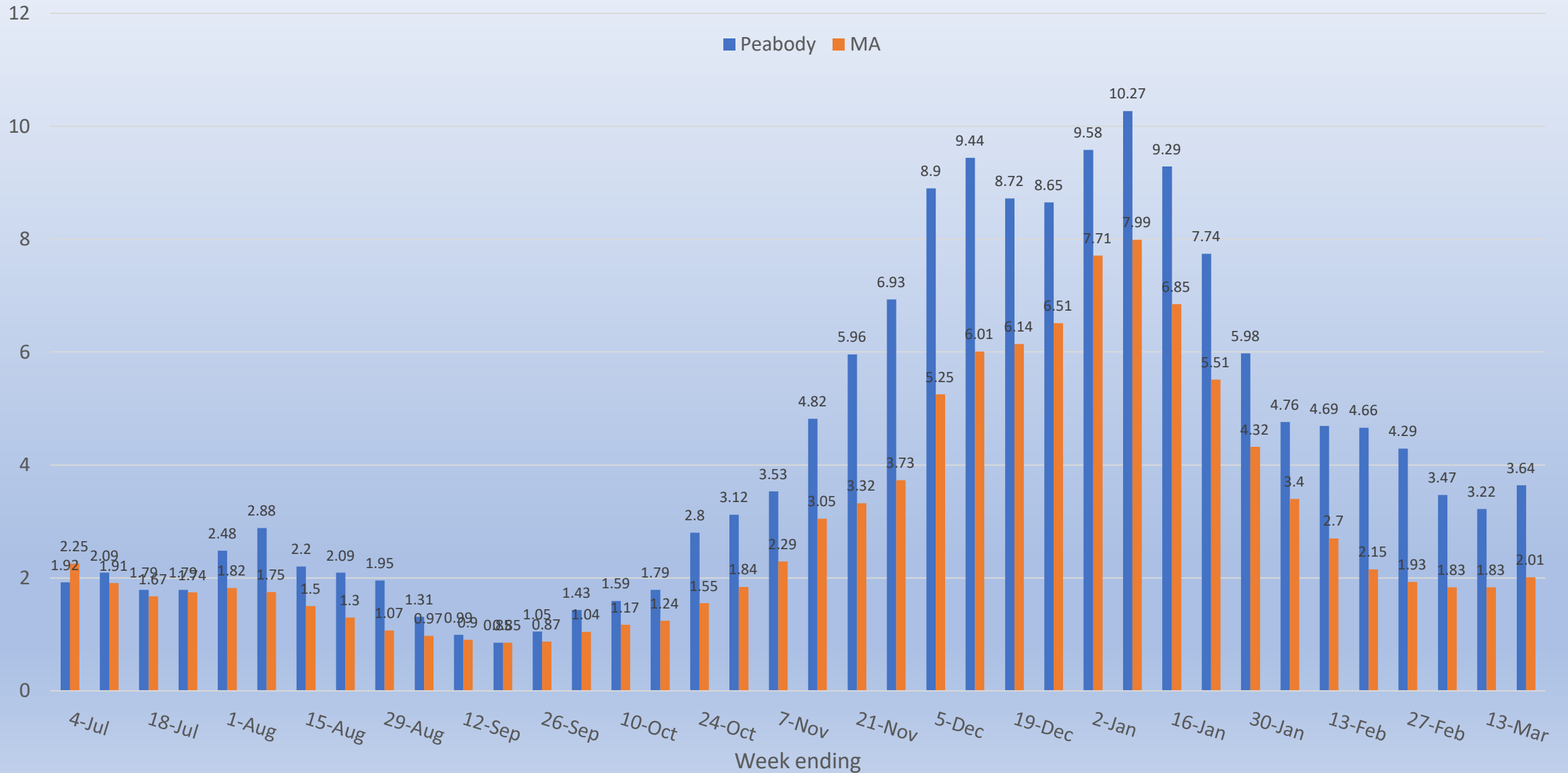
# Peabody Cumulative Confirmed Cases by Date – 3/22/21

# Percent Positivity, past 14 days

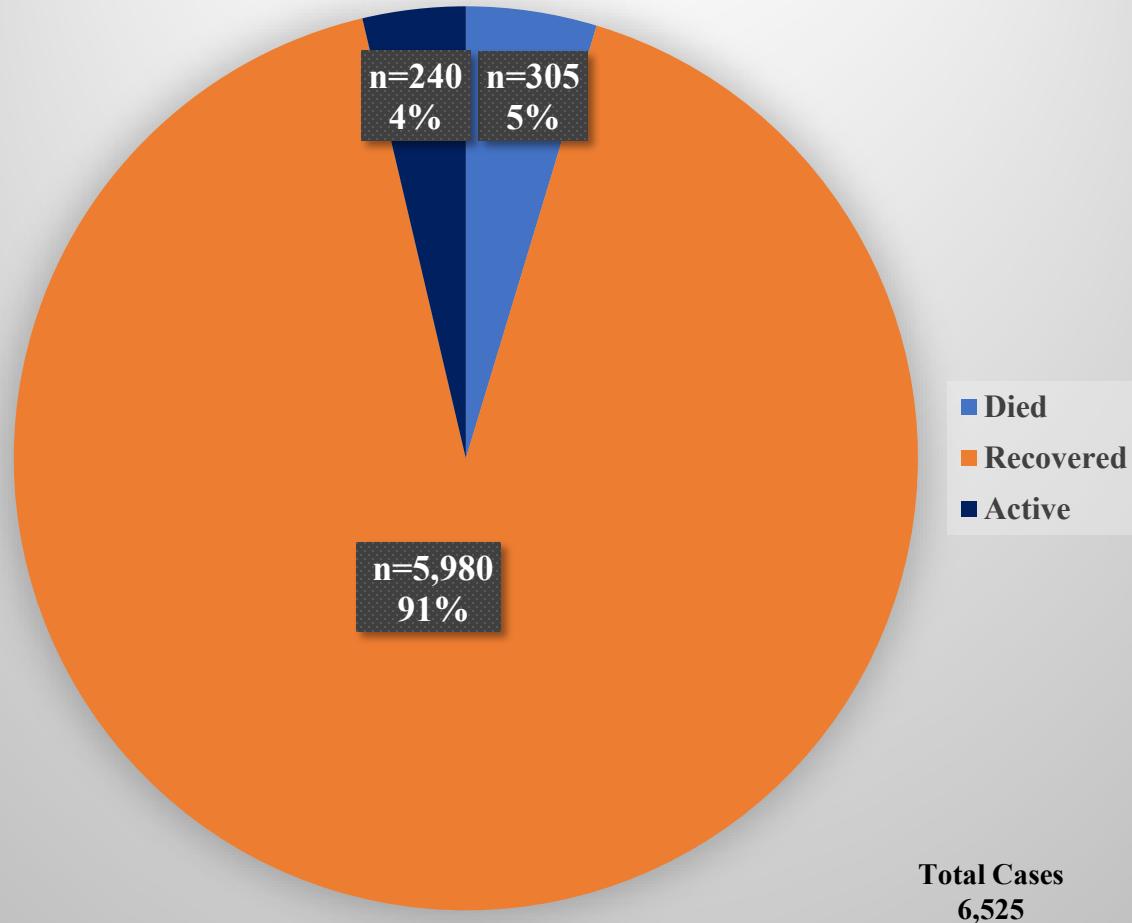

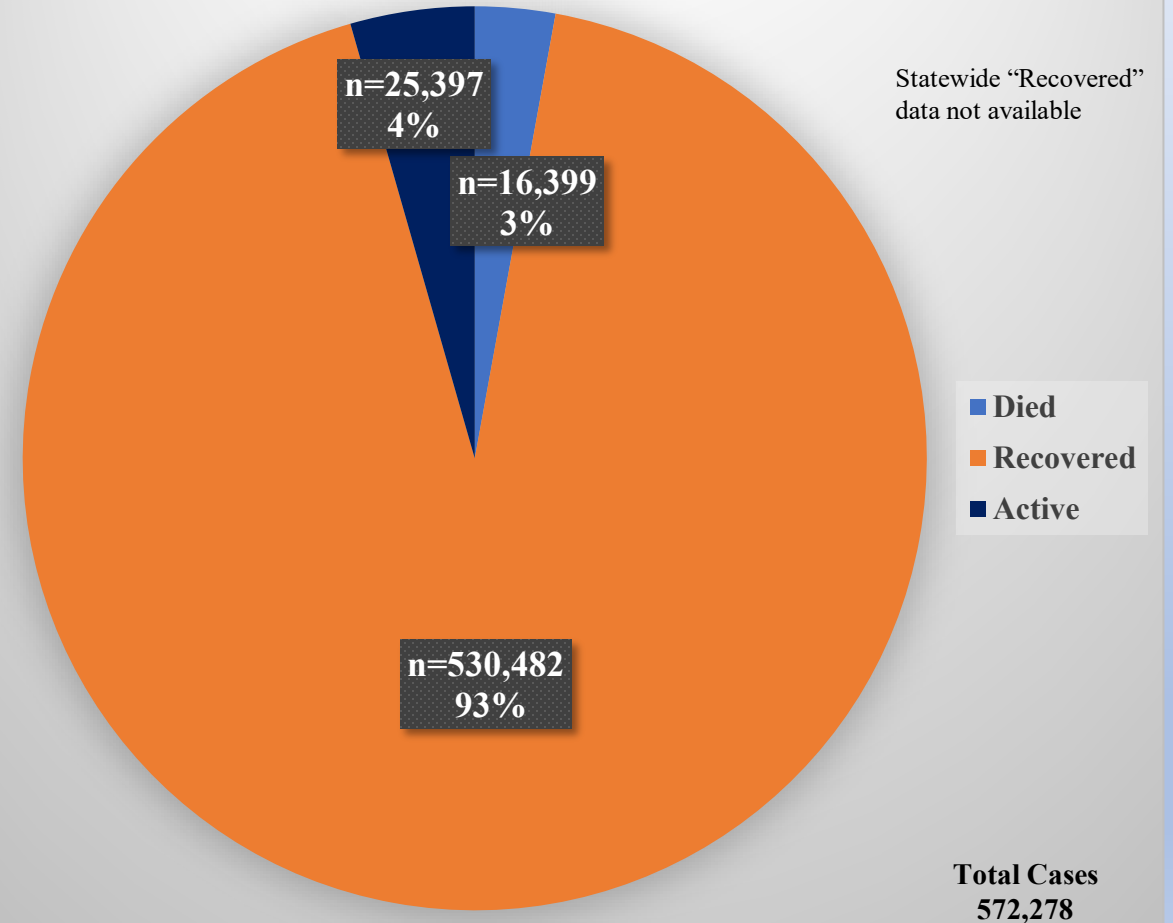

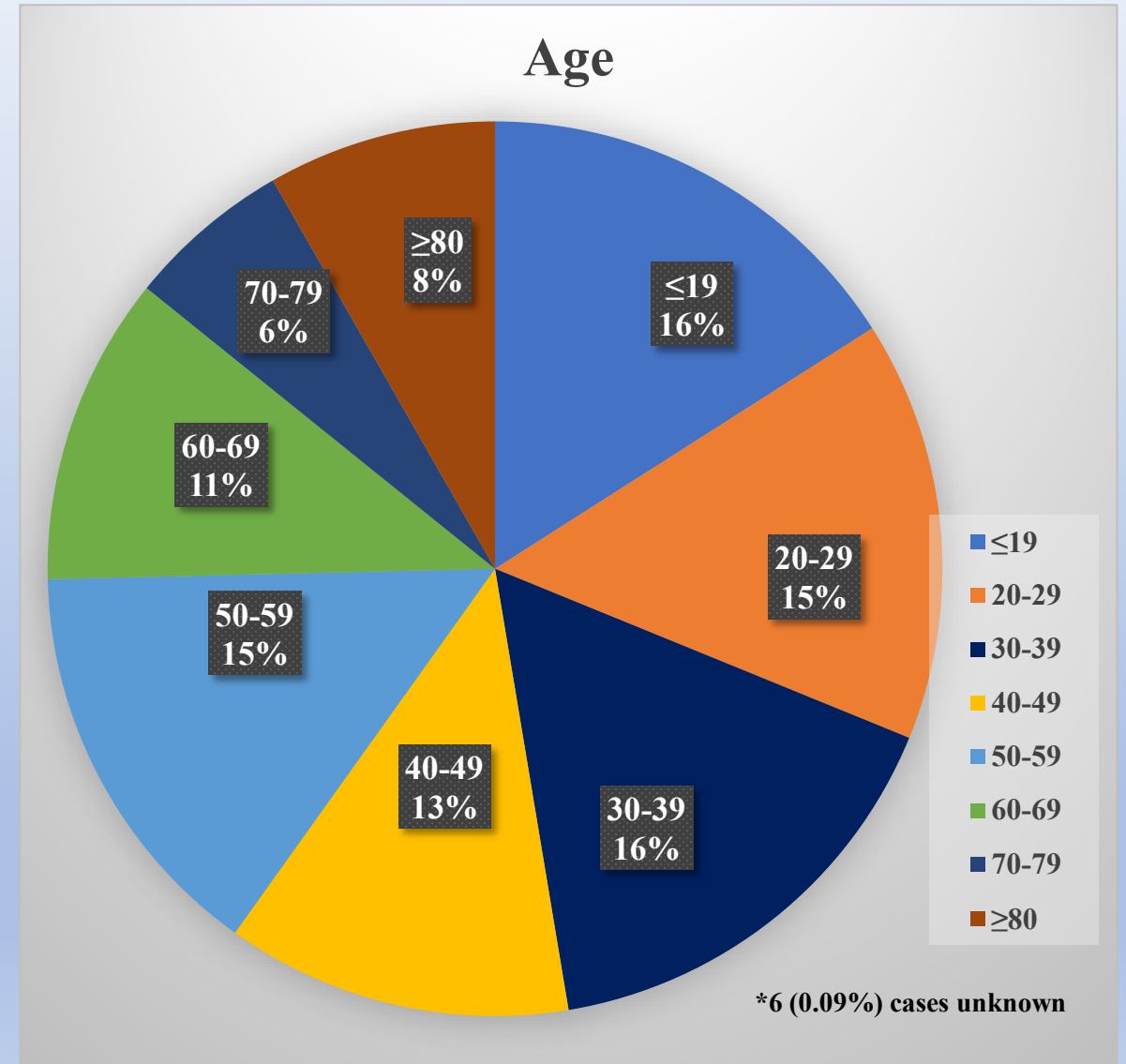

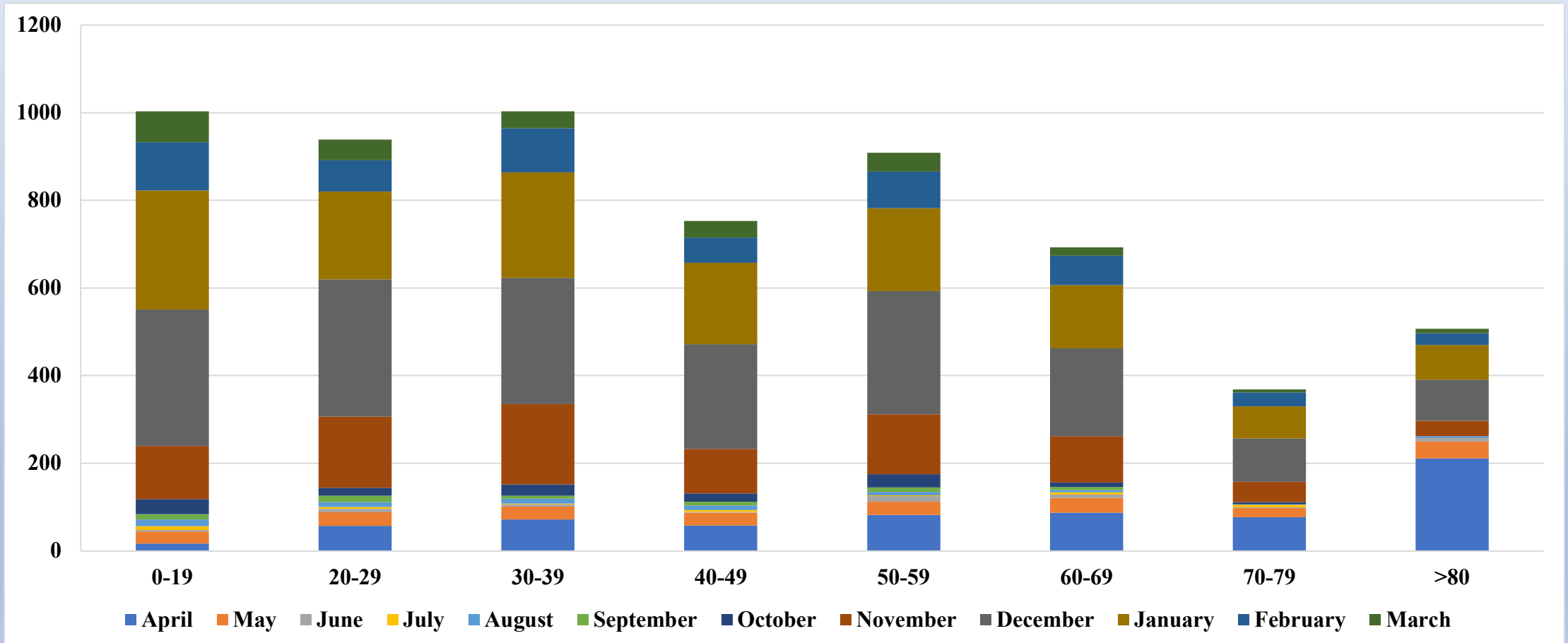


# COVID-19 – Peabody Cases by Gender & Age– 3/22/21

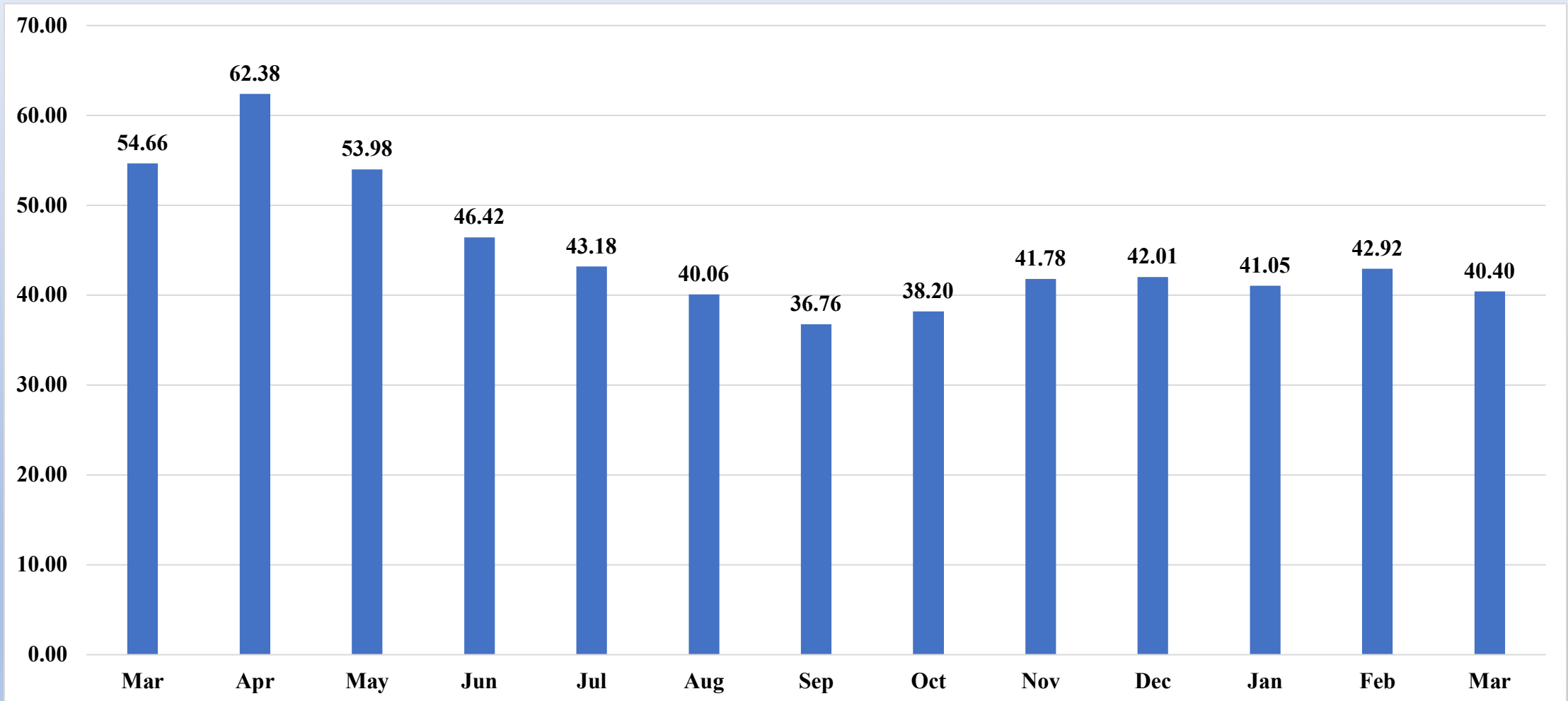


# Peabody COVID-19 Cases by Age Range

## April 1, 2020 to March 22, 2021

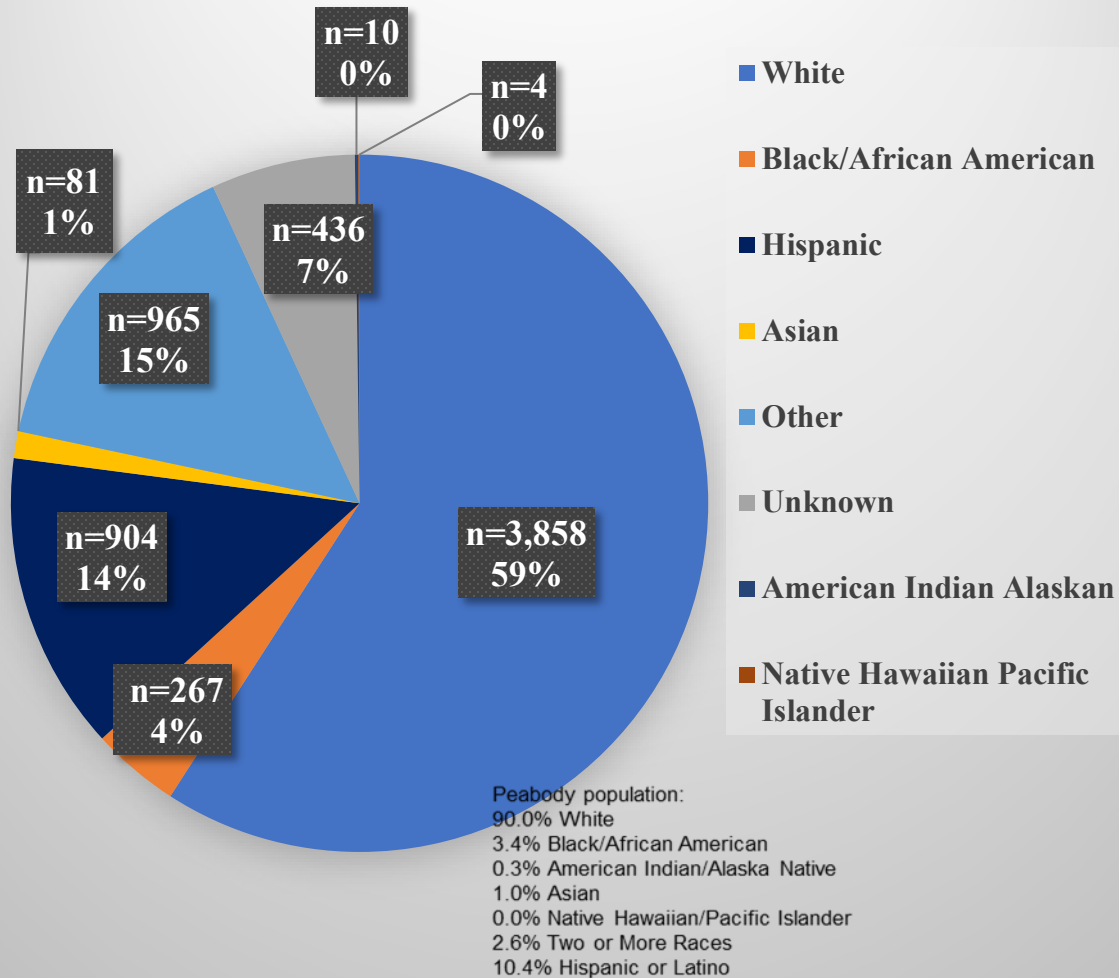


# Peabody Median Age of Cases By Month

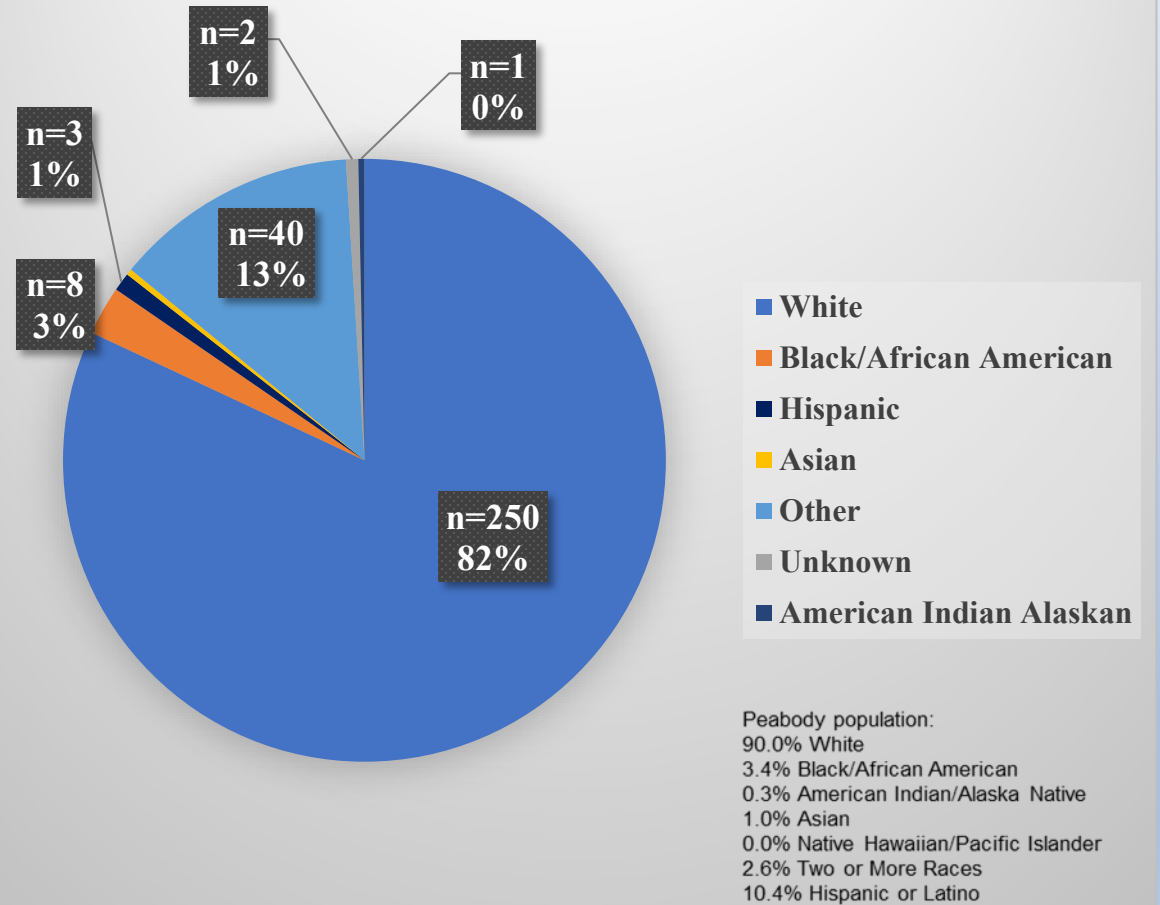

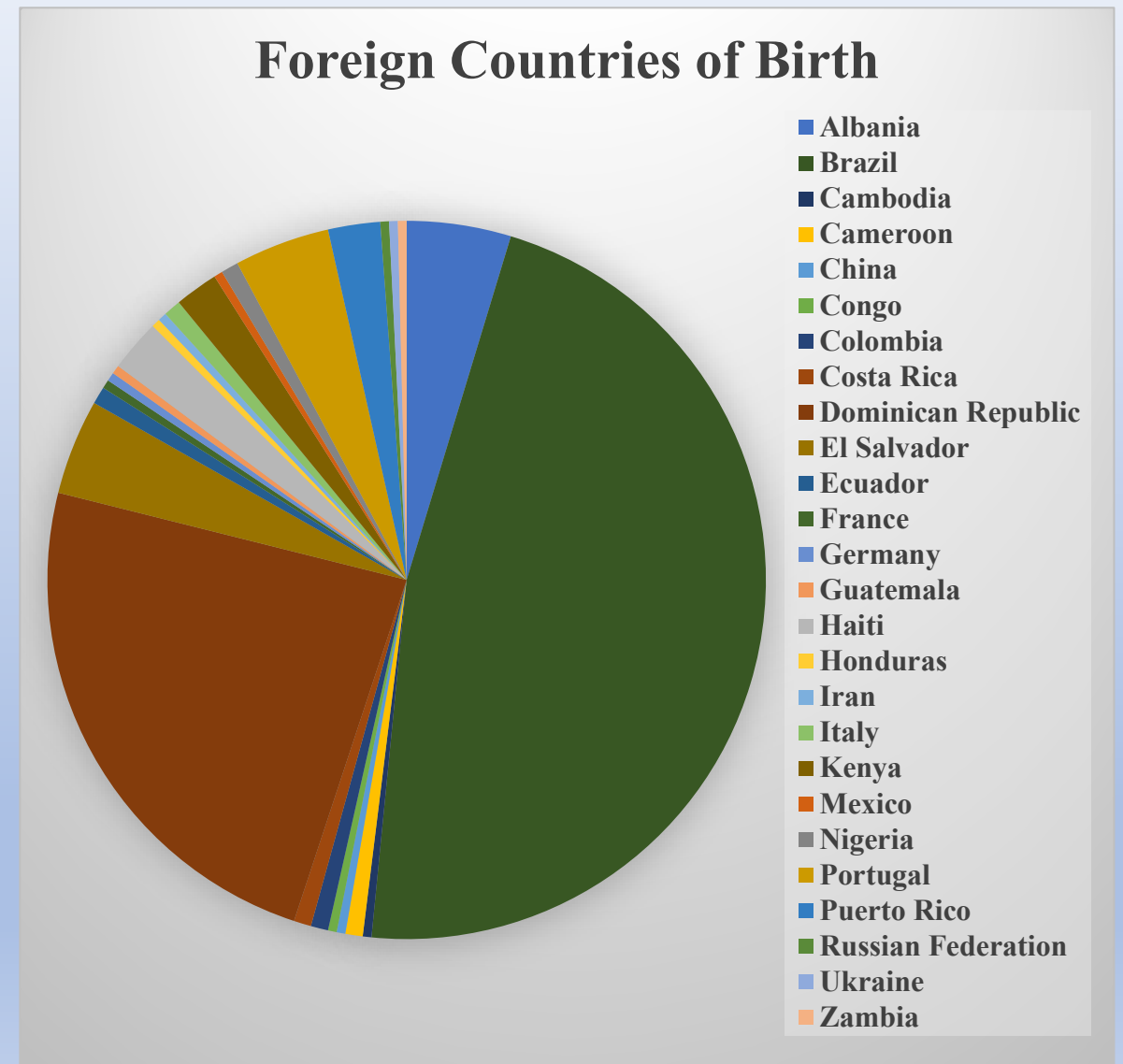
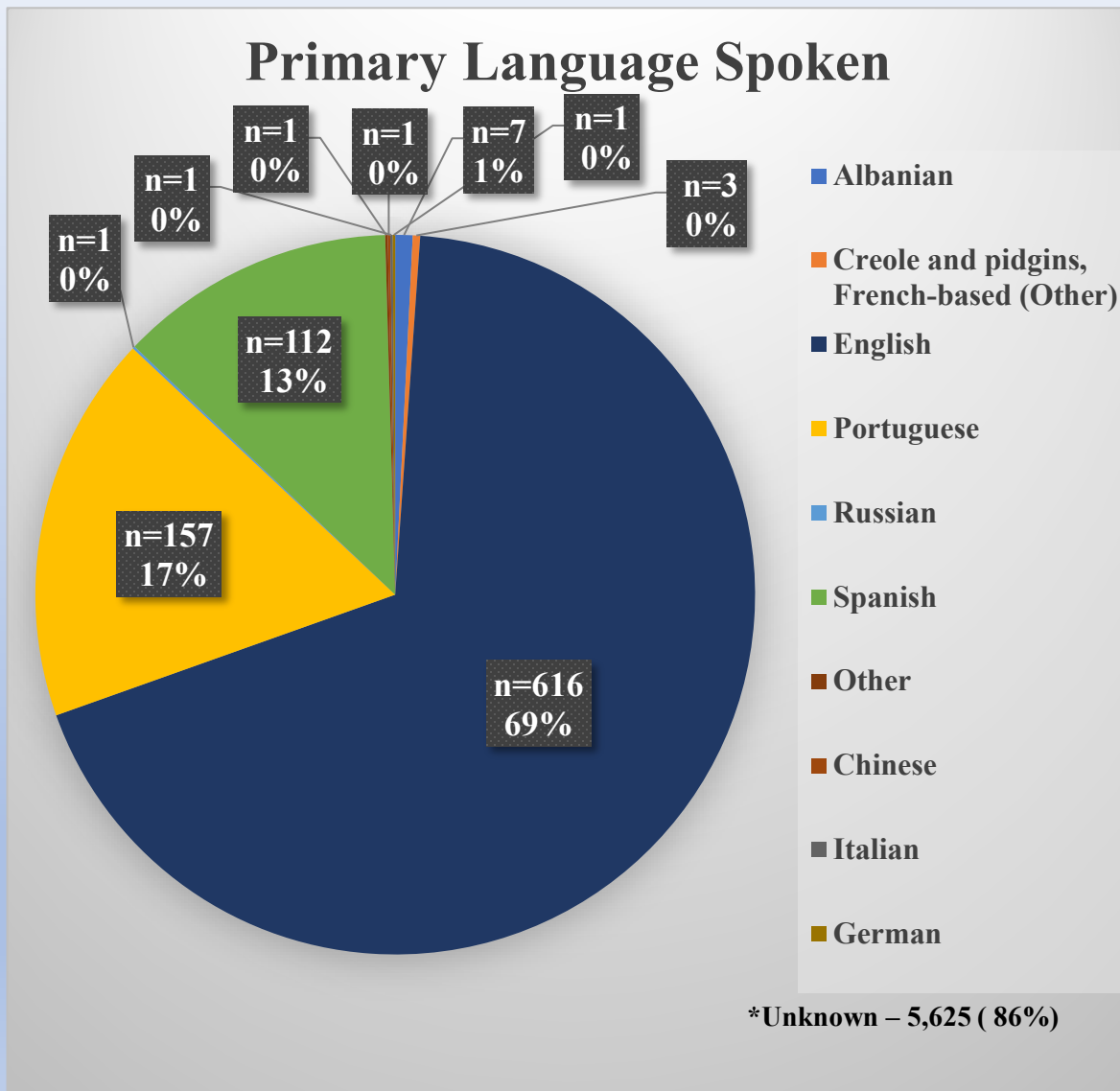

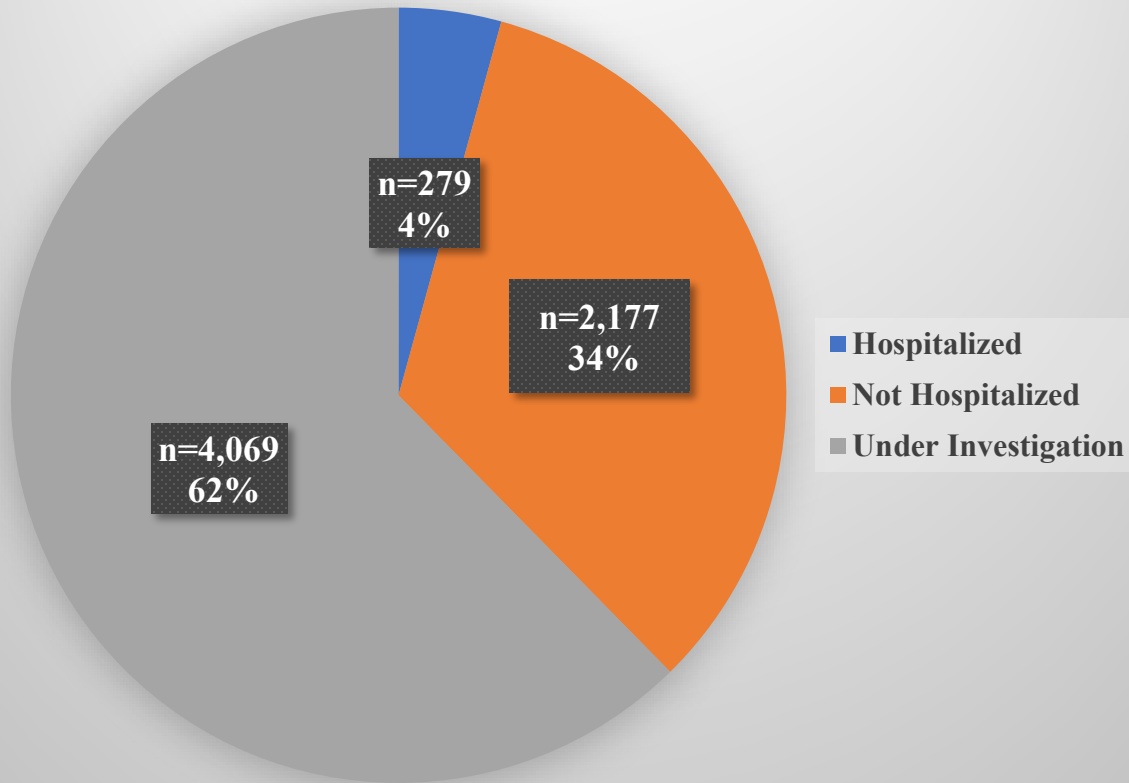

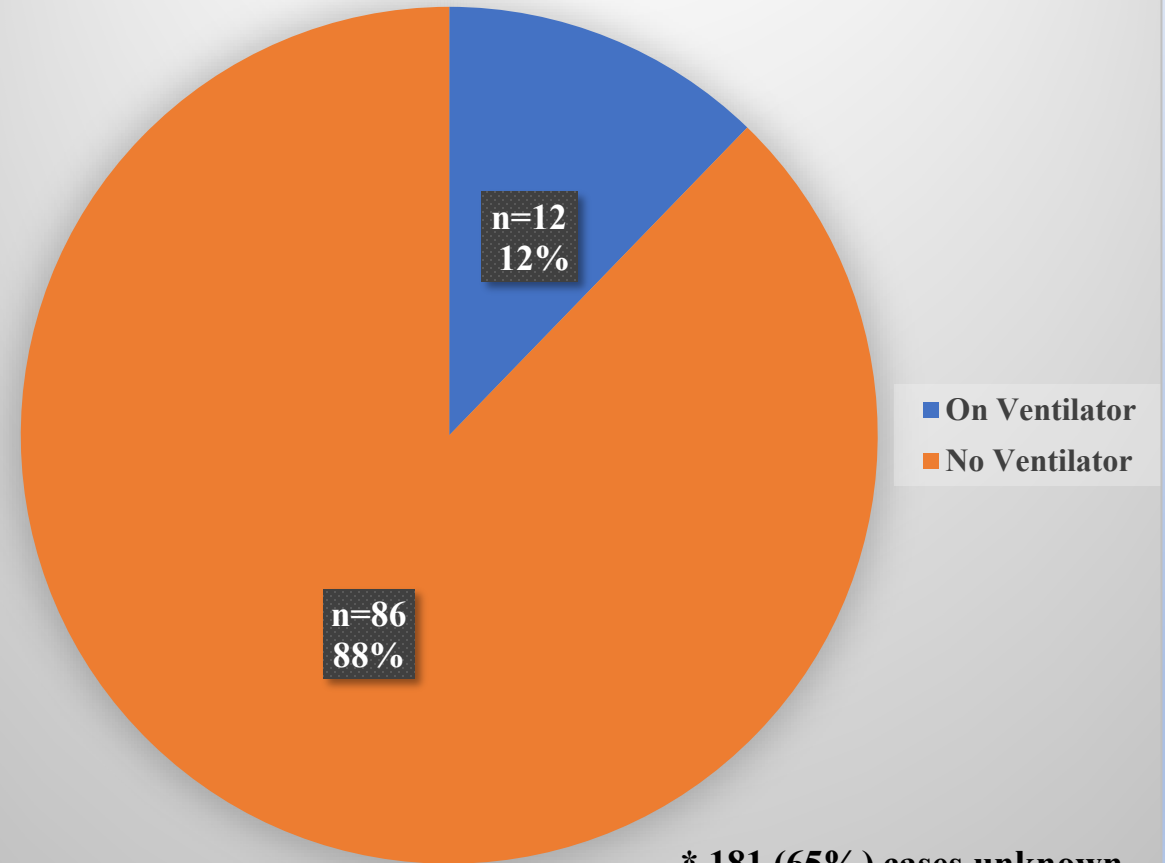

## Number of Hospitalizations

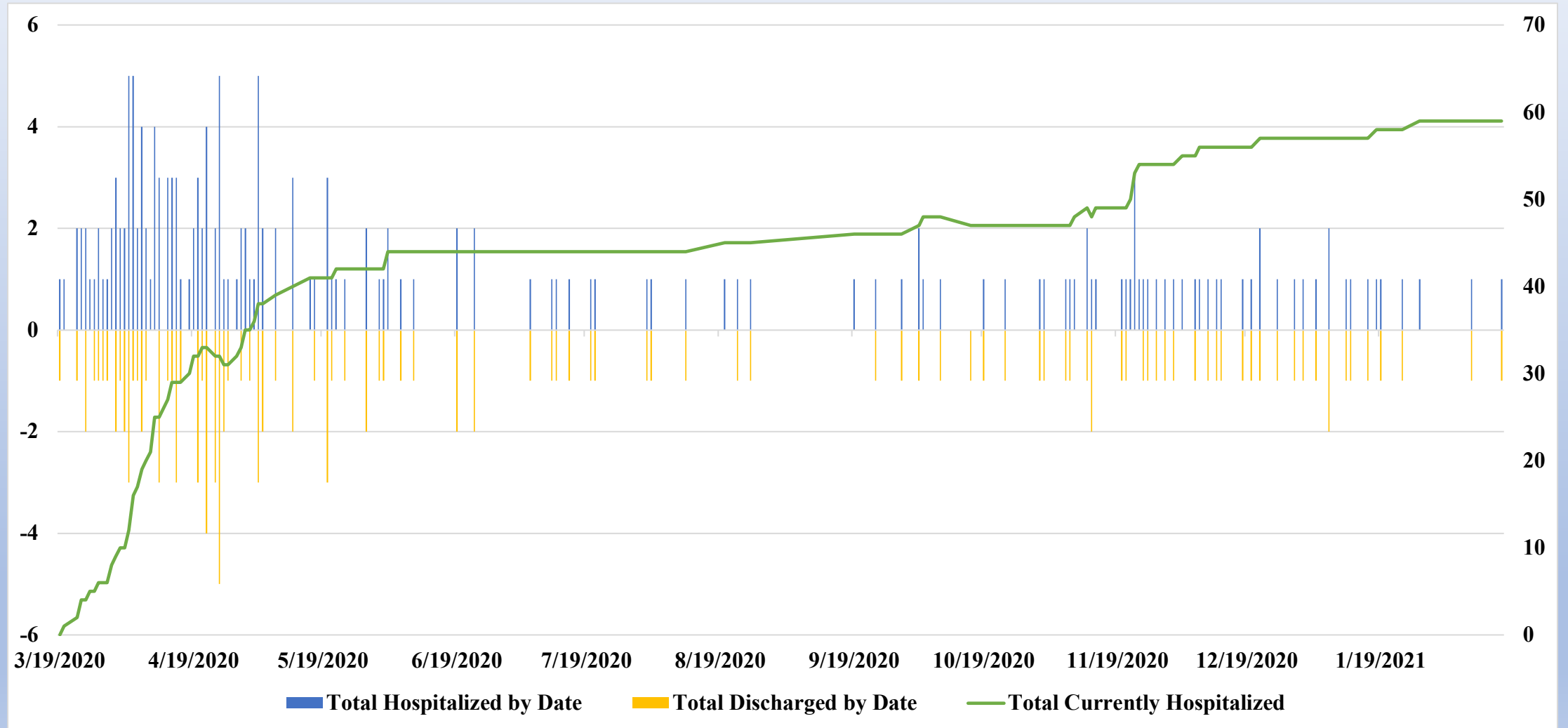


## Hospitalizations Needing Ventilator



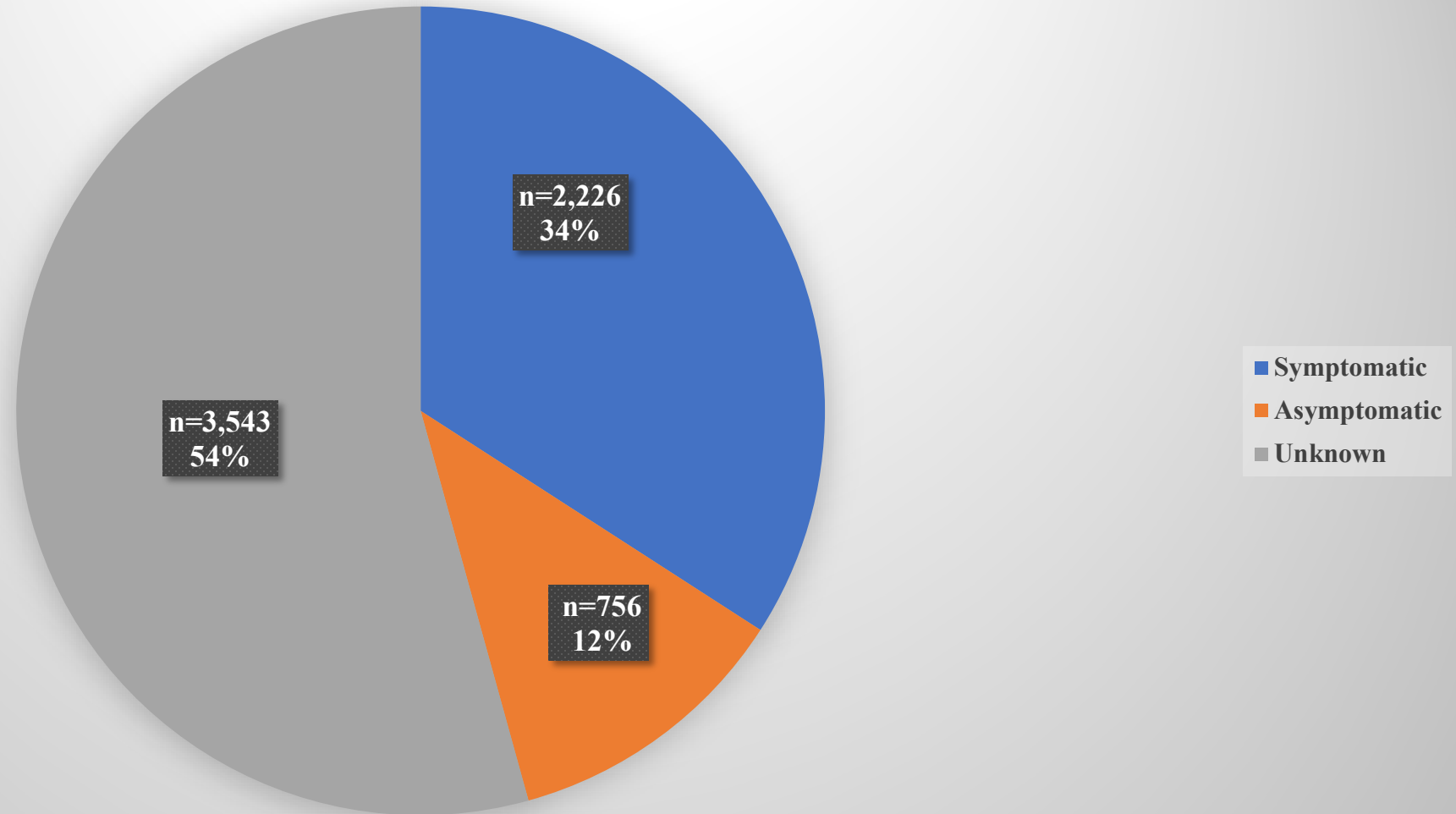

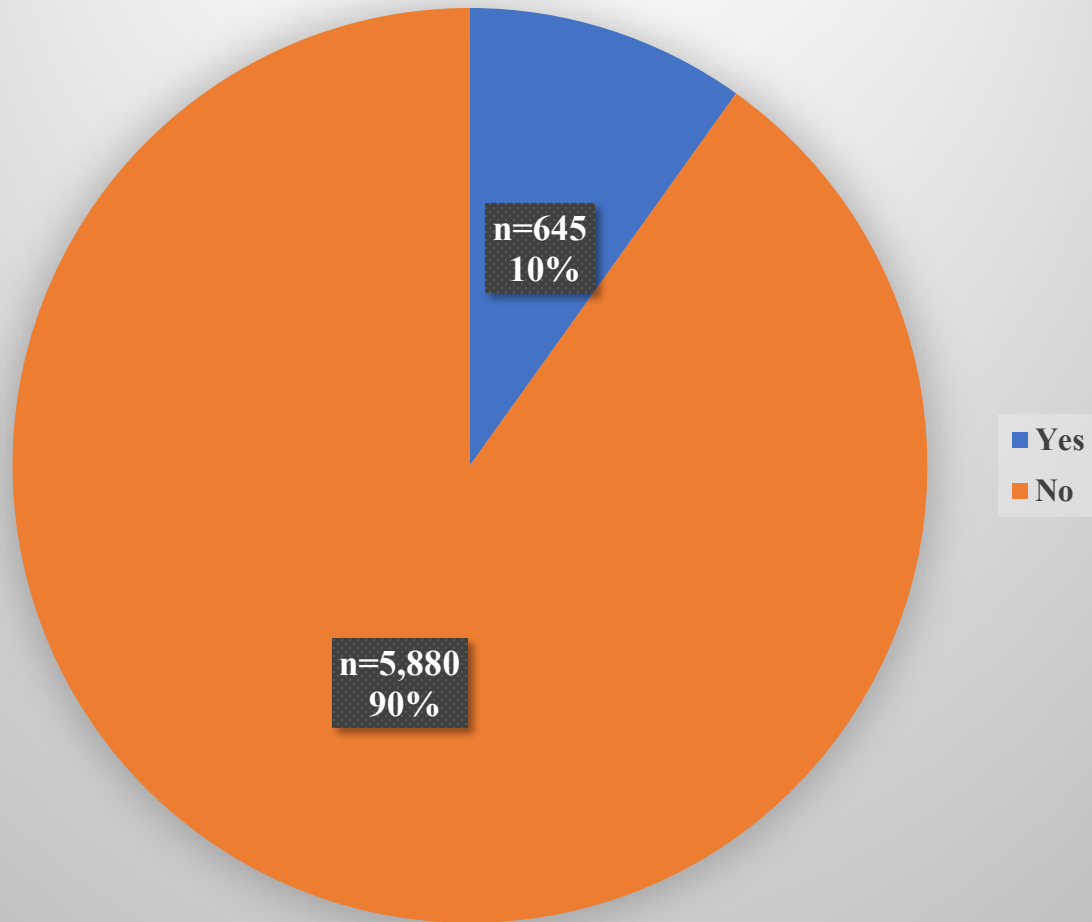

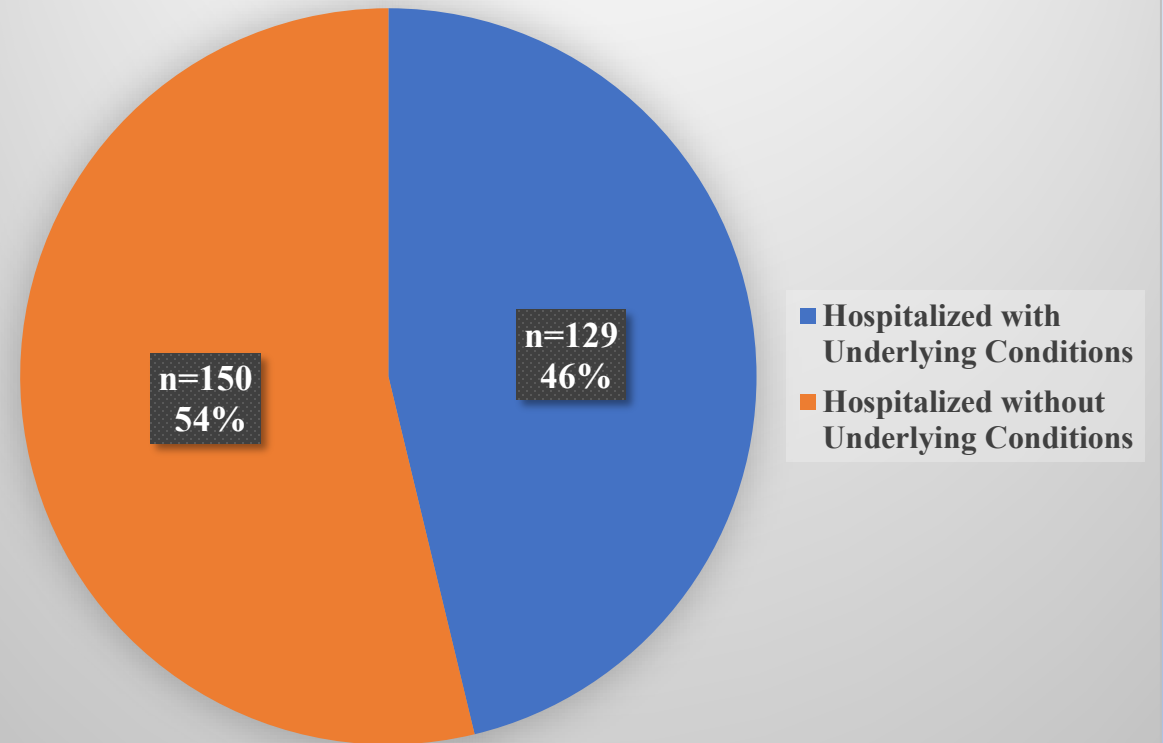

## Cases with Underlying Health Conditions

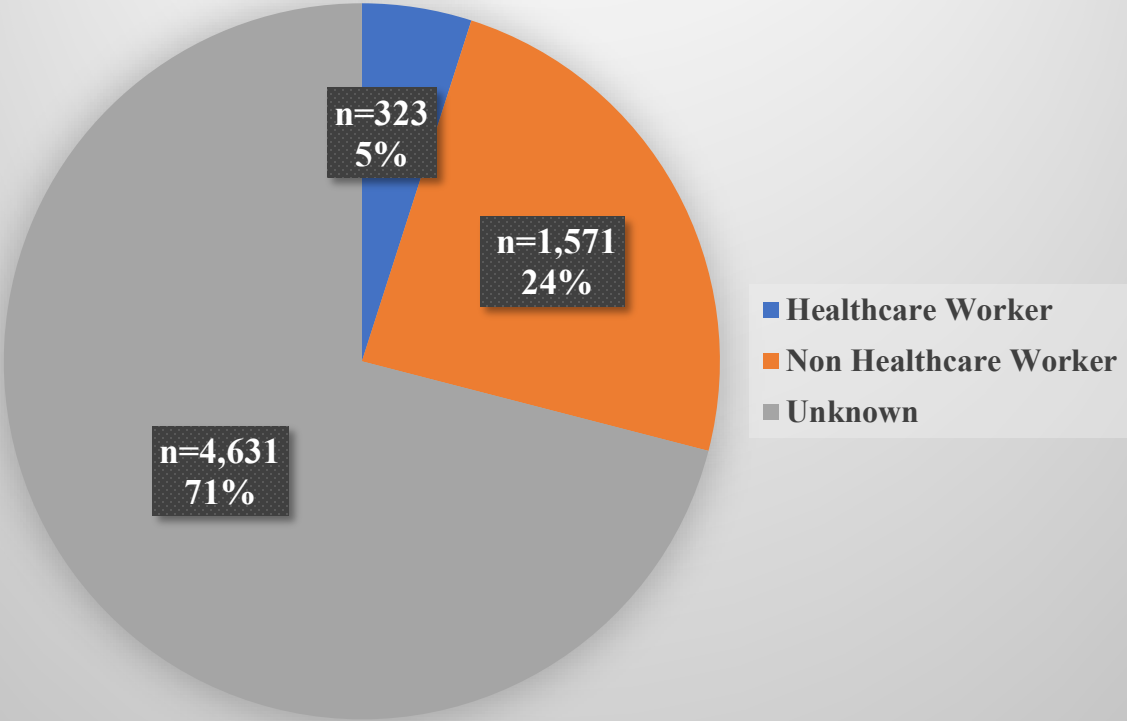


## Hospitalizations with Underlying Health Conditions

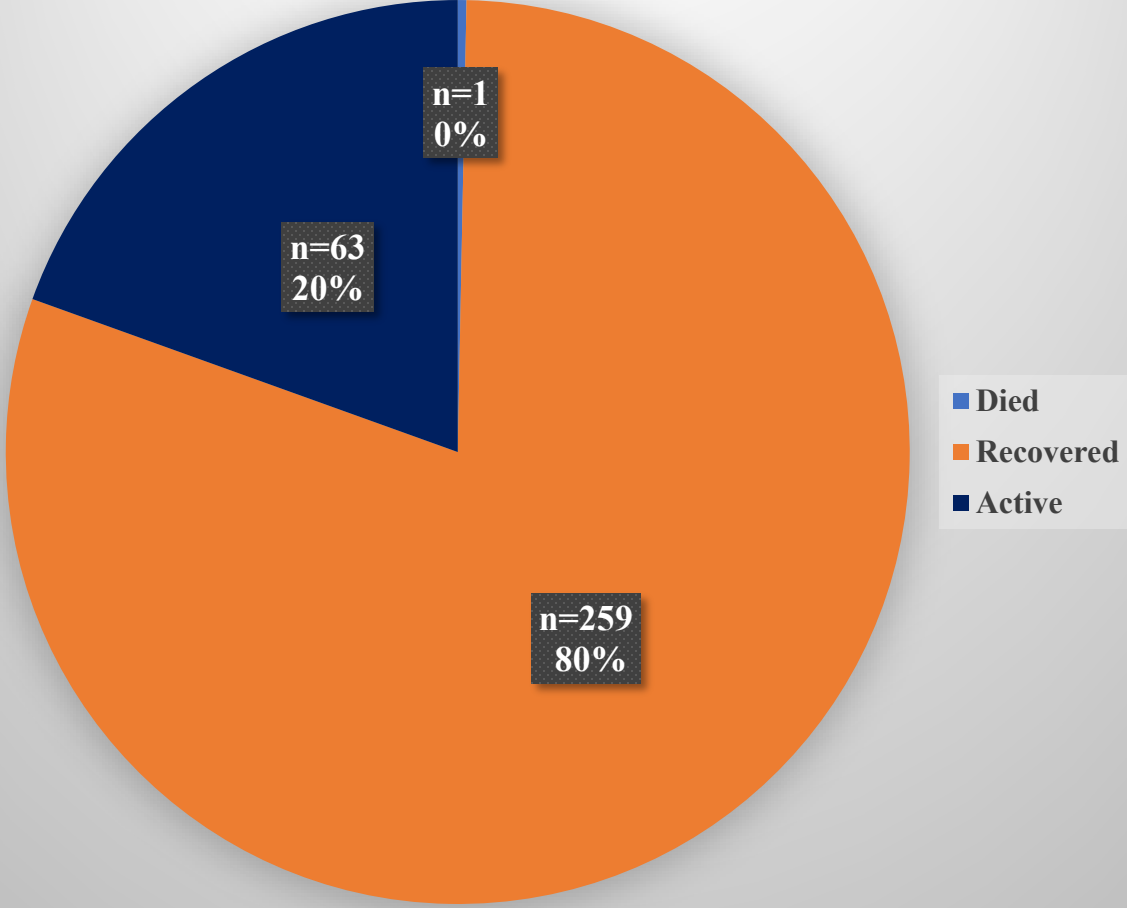

### Cases Among Healthcare Workers

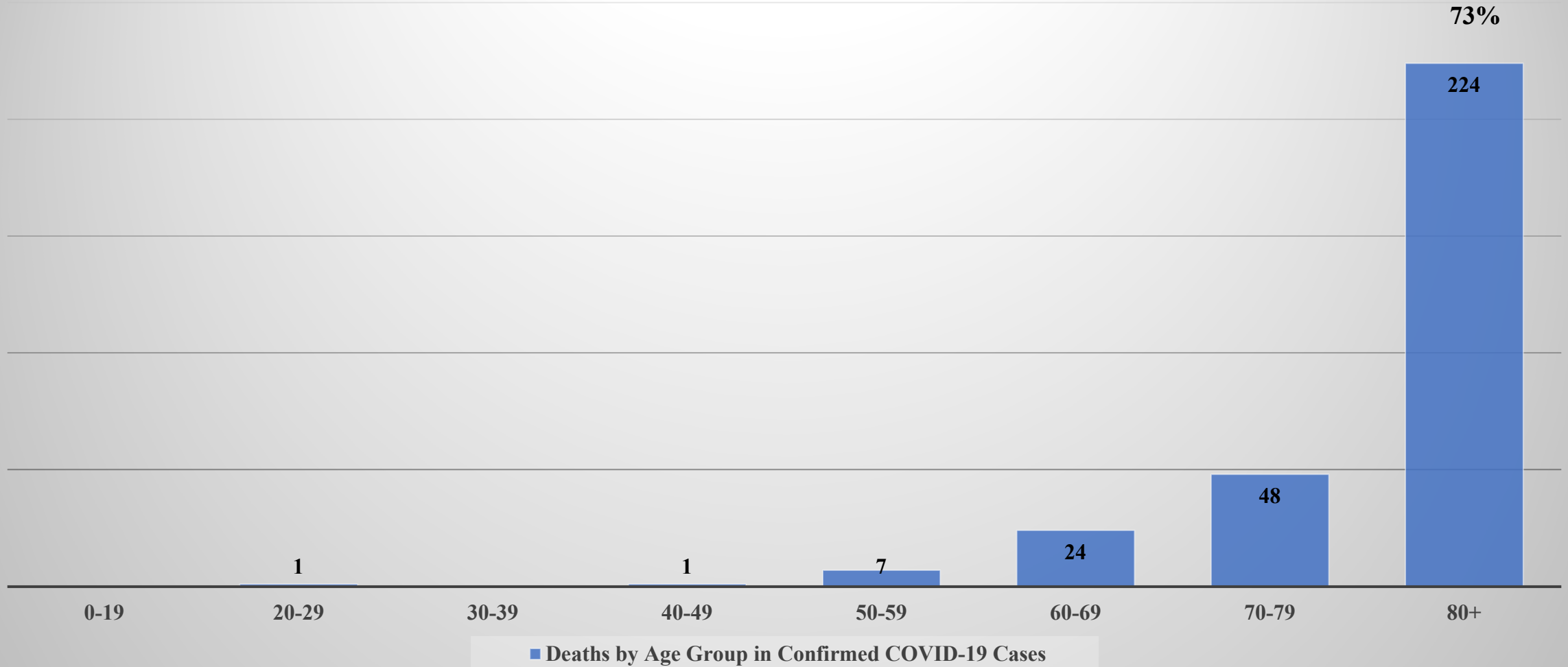

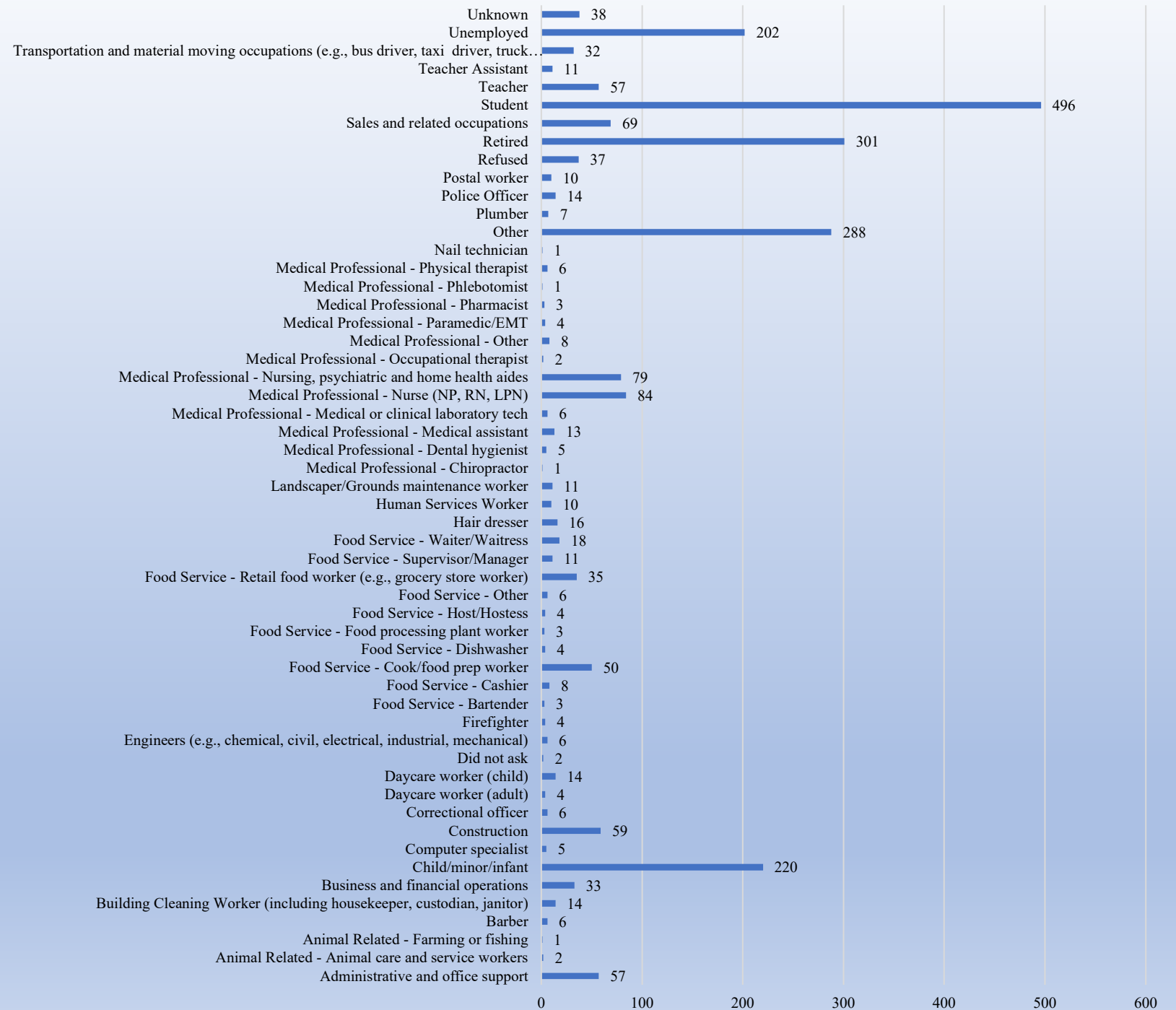

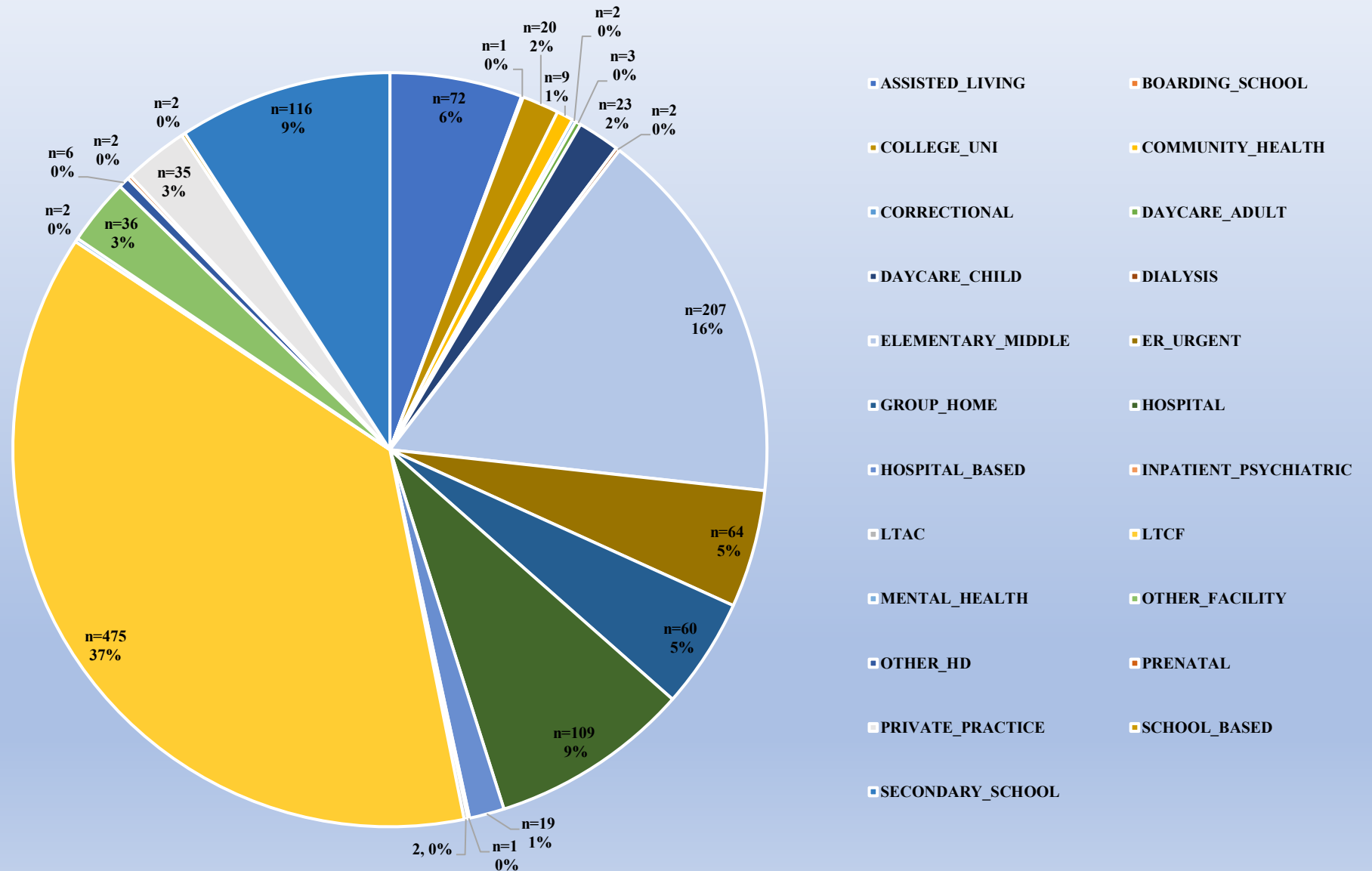
## Peabody Deaths by Age Group in Confirmed COVID-19 Cases



# Occupation Data September 1, 2020 to March 22, 2021



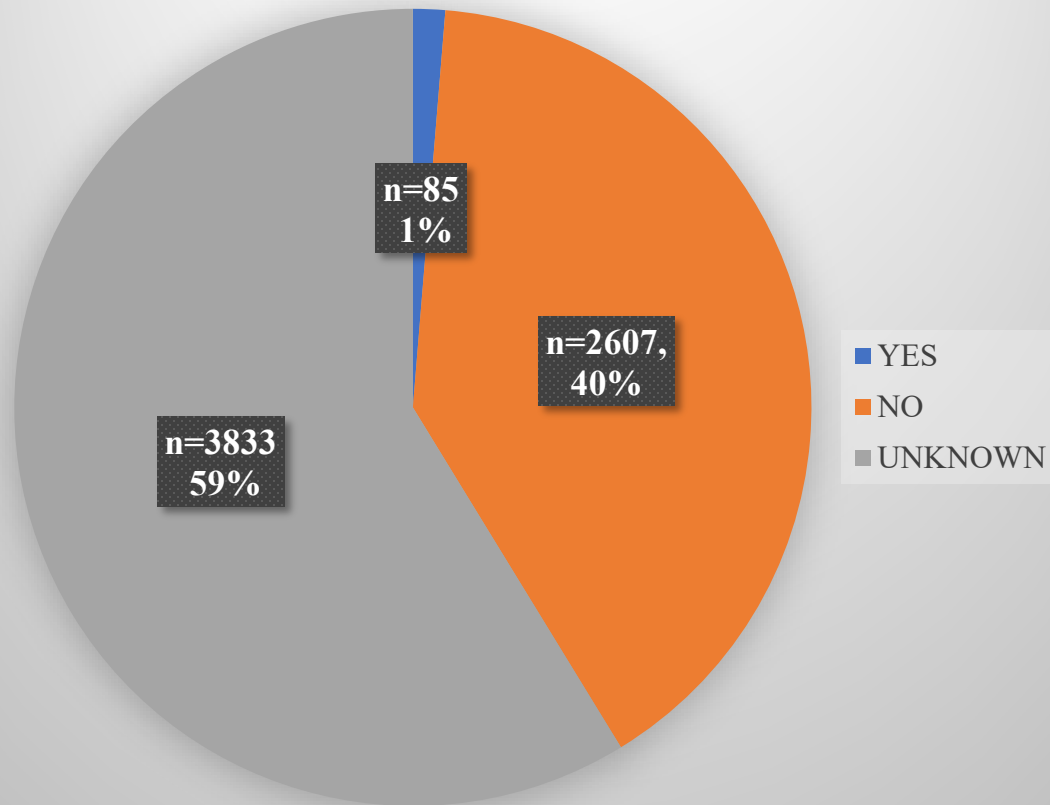

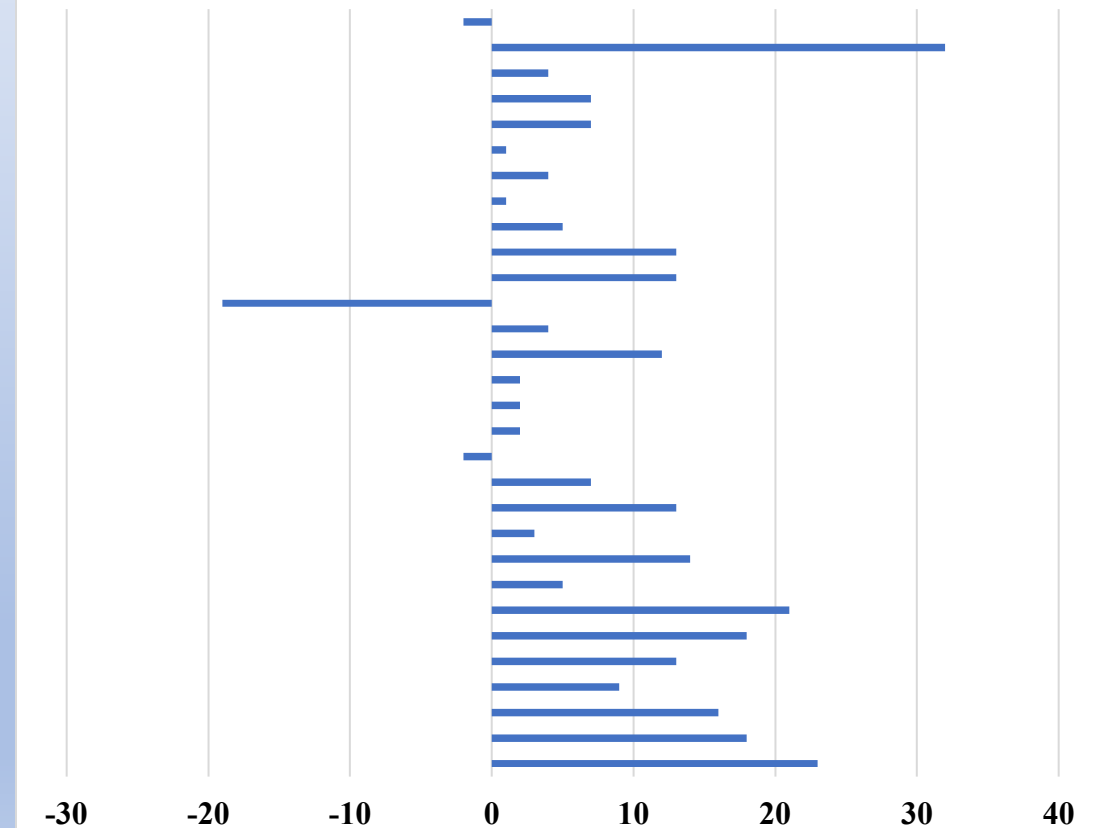

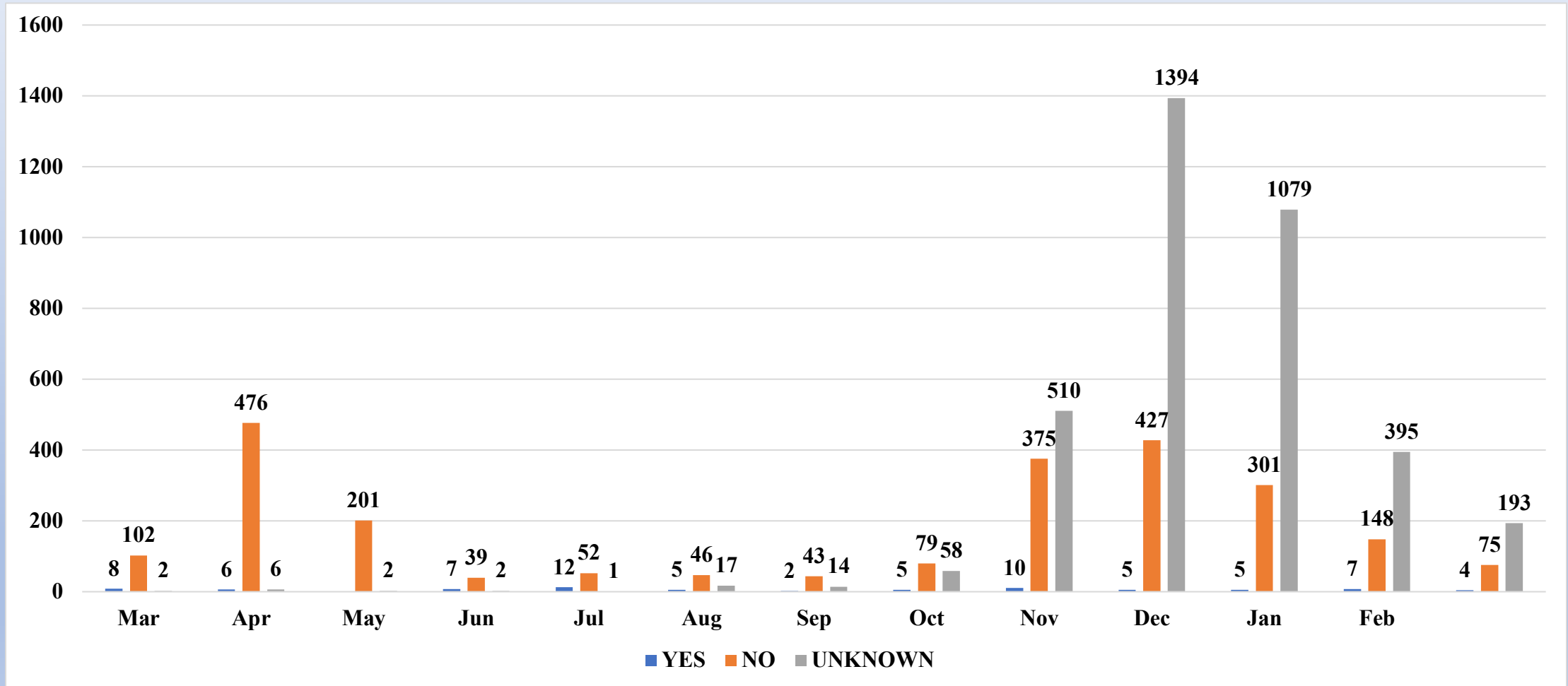
## Travel Before Symptom Onset



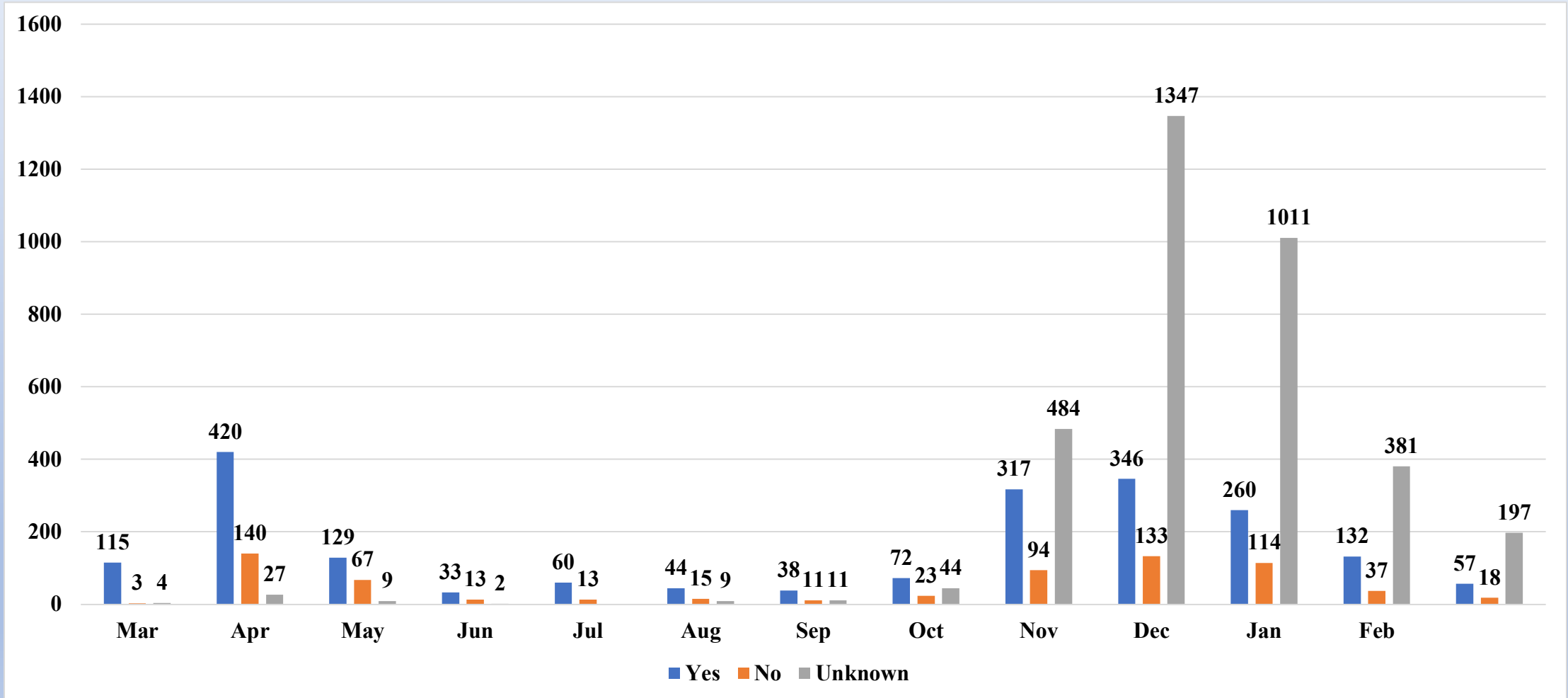
## Time Interval Between Travel and Symptom Onset

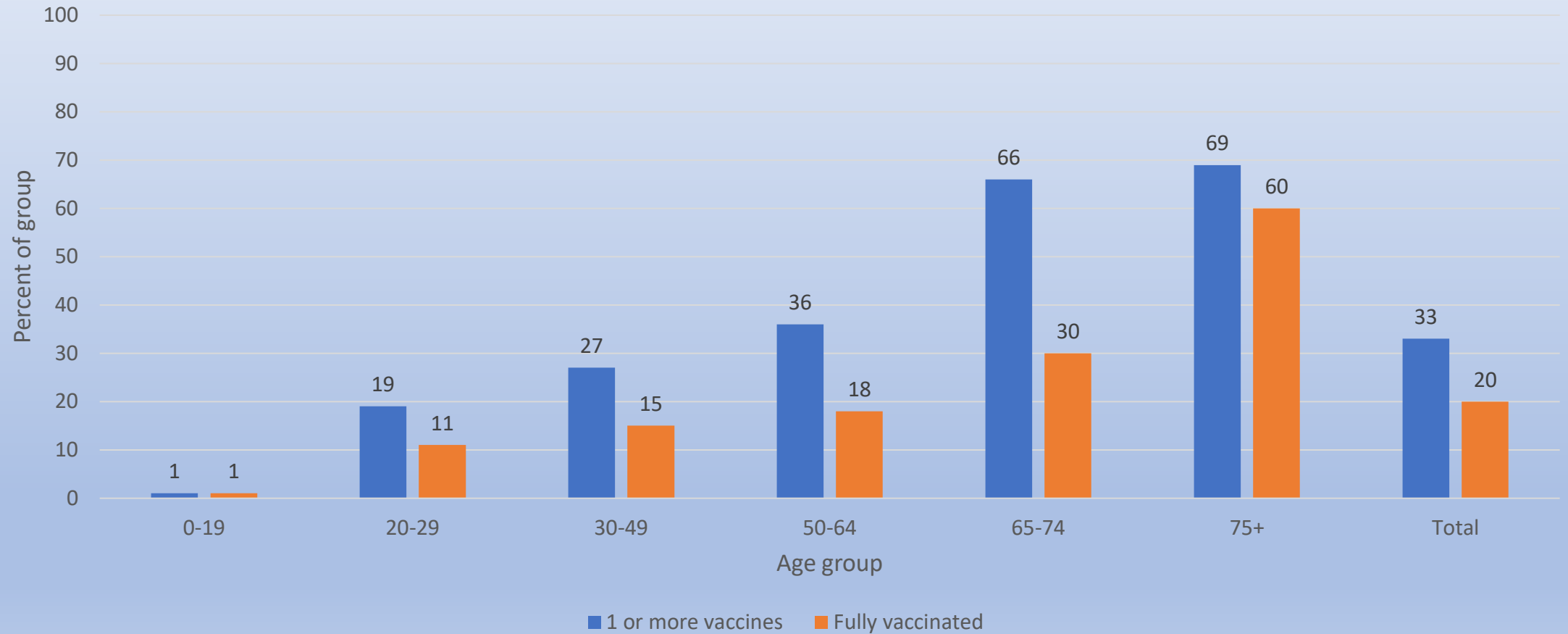

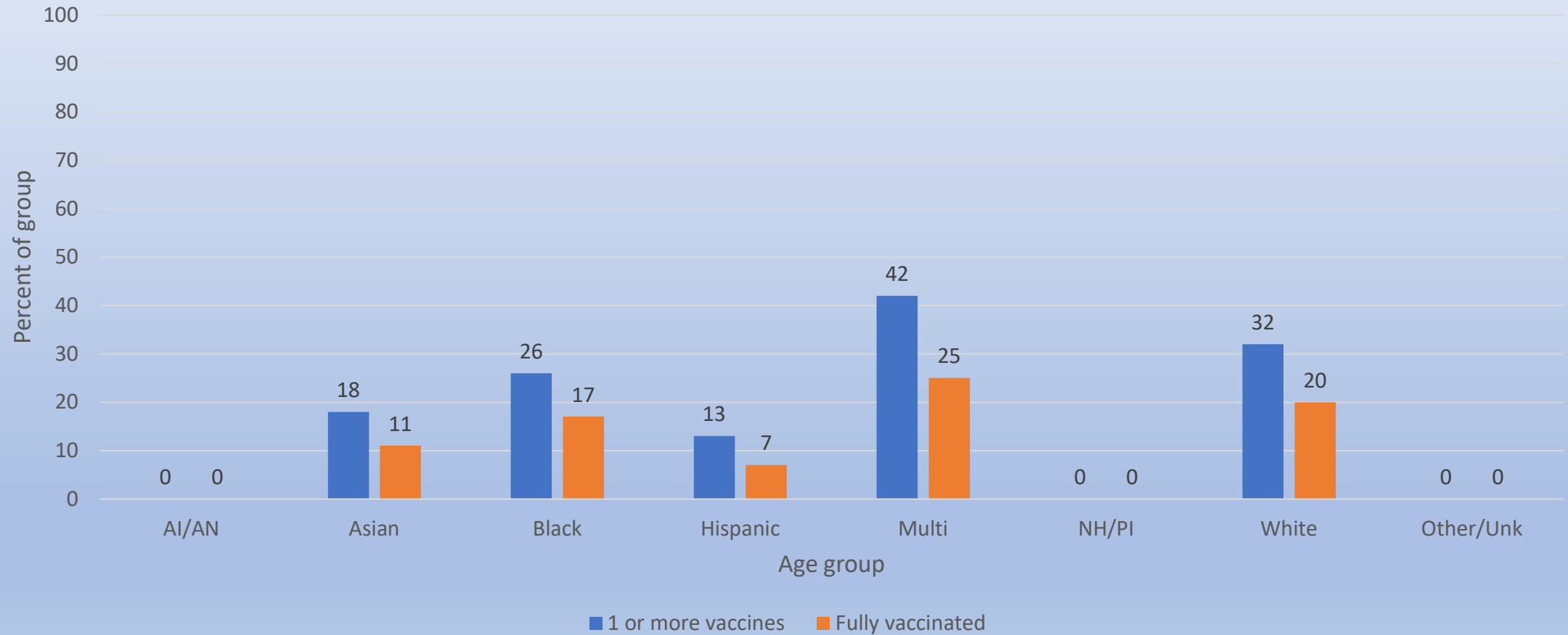

through 3/23/21

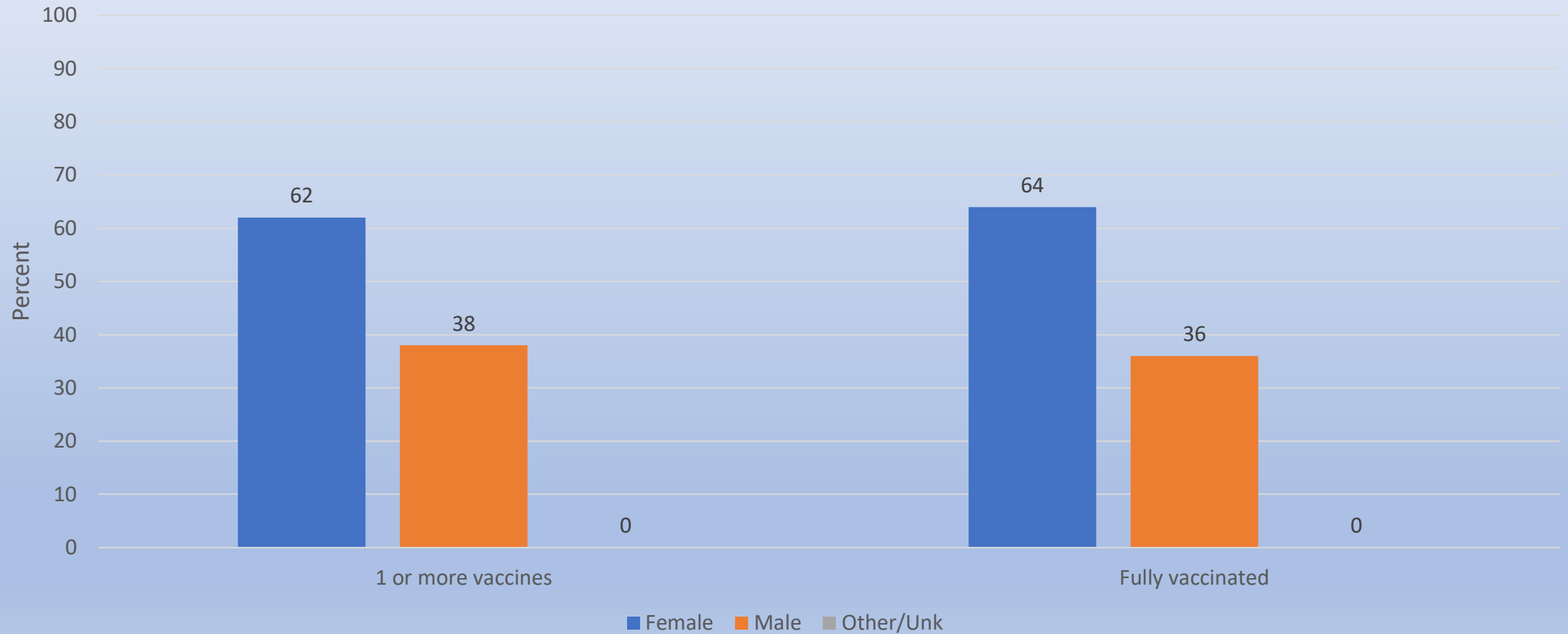


# Peabody residents vaccinated by race/ethnicity through 3/23/21
