

Have a child returning home from college?



If yes, make a plan for their safe re-entry back to Peabody. Even if your child had a negative test before coming home, this does not mean they are free from COVID-19. Take precautions within your household and be on the lookout COVID-19 symptoms.

Student coming home from college (excluding low risk states)



- Complete a MA Travel Form AND
 - Either have a negative PCR COVID-19* TEST within 72 hours before returning home/when home OR quarantine at home for 14 days.
- \$500 fine per day for failure to comply***
 *Positive COVID-19 test will be followed up by Health Department



Parent picking student up and staying >24 hours (excluding low risk states)**

****Parent driving student home and anyone else in car should wear a mask and open car windows to create airflow**

Precautions to consider for 14 days after return home	How to Stop the Spread
Stay home. Monitor for symptoms. https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html	Practice social distancing and wash hands frequently
Wear a mask (even indoors at home)	Wear a mask with anyone outside your household, even outdoors. <i>The state's updated face covering order includes all public places, at all times, even if social distancing is possible.</i>
Create distance during meals (eat outside when possible); sit at opposite ends of the table; open windows to create airflow.	If need to ride in a car with someone outside your household, wear a mask and open car windows for airflow
If possible, sleep in a separate room. Use a separate bathroom and disinfect any shared bathrooms after every use.	No parties! Large gatherings are not safe indoors or outdoors. The State announced 10pm stay at home advisory and reduced social gathering numbers: details here
